



# Timely Tips September

## Ornamentals & Lawn

1. Over seeding may be done in your yard if you did not use a *Fertilome Weed and Feed* or *Fertilome Crabgrass Preventer*.
2. If not using a weed preventer, sod may be installed or seeding lawns can be done.
3. Spring blooming bulbs may be planted. It is ideal to wait until cooler weather to plant tulip bulbs.
4. Divide summer or fall blooming perennials.
5. White pine and other evergreens may begin to show signs of needle drop towards the inside of the plant; this is perfectly normal.
6. Water trees, shrubs and perennials if adequate moisture is not present.
7. Plant trees, shrubs and perennials for good root growth before winter.
8. Rejuvenate containers and annual plantings with garden mums, asters, pansies and kale.

## Fruits and Veggies

1. Early in the month, sow cool season vegetables such as spinach, lettuces, carrots, radishes, and other leafy greens.
2. Harvest herbs and dry them for winter use.

## Houseplants

1. Ready houseplants and tropical plants to come indoors for the winter. Check for insects and treat if necessary.

## Birds & Wildlife

1. Spray *Liquid Fence* on perennials and other tasty plants in your yard to protect from fall deer feedings.
2. Protect trees from fall deer damage by applying tree wrap. Use white plastic to reflect sunlight.
