HYDRANGEA, ALICE

A superior selection of Oakleaf Hydrangea that branches well and produces a full, rounded, and large shrub that bears 12-inch long white flower spikes aging to a lovely rose-pink as they mature. Stunning burgundy-red fall color and peeling cinnamon bark make this an outstanding year-round shrub. Matures at 8 to 12 feet tall and wide. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, BLOOMSTRUCK This hydrangea explodes with Mophead blooms on reddish stems that cover rounded, compact plants. Blooms mature to shades of purple or rosy red (depending on soil pH) extending the display into fall, followed by rich, burgundy-red foliage. Flowering occurs on both old wood and new growth, assuring flowers even after a severe winter. Height on this plant grows to 3-4'tall with a 4-5' spread. Part shade Zone 4



HYDRANGEA, BOBO

A delightful plant that is engulfed by large white flowers in summer and turning a pinkish color in fall. The flowers are held upright on strong stems and continue to grow and lengthen as they bloom. Grows to 3 feet tall and 4 feet wide. Sun to part sun Zone 3



HYDRANGEA, BOMBSHELL

Bombshell Hydrangea's abundant white blooms cover the dark green foliage from summer until frost. It's a low maintenance plant with a compact habit reaching 2.5 to 3 feet tall with a spread of 3 to 4 feet. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



HYDRANGEA, CITYLINE

Intense fuchsia blooms on strong, erect stems makes this plant a garden winner. Dark green foliage on this medium-sized, mounding shrub grows 1 to 3 feet tall and wide. Great for use in containers and as cut flowers. Full sun to part sun Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, END. SUMMER Aptly named, this Hydrangea has great appeal because of the large, mop head flowers that begin to bloom in spring and repeat through fall. A very cold-hardy selection. Blooms are pink in alkaline soils and blue in acidic soils. Matures at 3 to 5 feet tall and wide. Part sun Zone 4



HYDRANGEA, FIRE AND ICE

A compact, early blooming, heat tolerant selection with attractive greenish-red foliage all season. Blooms open creamy white in early summer, turn pink in mid-summer, becoming deep red in fall. A beautiful accent, foundation or border shrub for the garden. Deciduous. Reaches 3-4 ft. tall and wide. Full shade to part sun Zone 3



HYDRANGEA, INCREDIBALL

An improved Annabelle Hydrangea features sturdy stems and stupendously large, creamy-white blooms. Flowers open green, then mature to white before turning green at the end of their life cycle. This prolific bloomer will **mature to heights of 4 to 5 feet.** Makes a great cut flower. Full sun to part shade Zone 4



HYDRANGEA, LETS DANCE

A lacecap Hydrangea that blooms on new wood. Bright pink/blue blooms sit atop strong stems. Dark green foliage covers this beauty.

Matures at 2 to 3 feet tall. A perfect shrub for cut flowers. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, LIMELIGHT

The bright 6-8 inch lime-green flower heads are held upright on this shrub and are followed in autumn by deep pink blooms. **Mature height** is 8' tall and as wide, but can be pruned to desired height. The autumn display of both blooms on the same plant is exquisite. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



HYDRANGEA, LITTLE LIME

Approximately one-third the size of Limelight with the same great features. This dwarf Hydrangea offers more versatility in the landscape. **Grows to 3 to 5 feet tall and wide**. Great for mixed border or foundation plantings. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



HYDRANGEA, PEE WEE OAK.

A wonderful dwarf Oakleaf Hydrangea that **matures at 3 to 4 feet tall and wide.** Abundant white flower heads appear in early to mid-summer followed by excellent wine-red fall leaf color. A great selection for smaller gardens. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, PHANTOM

Huge, conical, cream colored panicles appear on this beautiful plant from summer to fall. **Grows to a large, 8' tall if left unpruned.** Shear back in early spring for a more dense growth habit. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



HYDRANGEA, PINKY WINKY

Large, 12 to 16-inch, two-toned blooms in white and pink. The new flowers are white and occur at the tip of the panicle. Strong stems hold the flowers upright. A beauty against its dark green foliage. **Matures at 6 to 8 feet tall.** Full to part sun Zone 3



HYDRANGEA, QUICK FIRE

This hardy Hydrangea is early to bloom. The flowers are quick to turn pink and show at least a month before other varieties. Will turn to a dark pink in fall. Blooms are not affected by soil pH. **Grows 6-8 feet tall and wide.** Sun to part sun Zone 3



HYDRANGEA, RUBY SLIPPERS A compact, shrub with large flowers that start white, fade to pink and then turn to a deep rose. Rich, dark green leaves turn mahogany-red in fall. Reaches 3 to 4 feet tall and 4 to 5 feet wide. Part sun to part shade Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, SNOWFLAKE

Coarse, oak-like foliage is characteristic of this deciduous shrub. Its 15 inch, double, white, lacecap blooms slowly fade to pink as the season progresses. Lovely burgundy fall foliage. Will grow to 6 feet tall and nearly as wide. Part sun Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, STRAW. SUND.

Hydrangea Strawberry Sundae is full of blooms & wonderfully compact for small space gardening. Strawberry Sundae shares all the great features of its cousin, Vanilla Strawberry with one important exception, its smaller stature. Flowers emerge in summer a creamy white, change to pink & finally to strawberry red. Full to part sun Zone 4



HYDRANGEA, SWEET SALSA

Wide compact with unique bronze red foliage with rich red stems. Bicolor red and white flowers with shades of pink. A show stopper. Grows 2 to 3 feet tall and 3 to 5 feet wide. Part sun to shade Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, TUFF STUFF

Lovely reddish-pink lacecap flowers create a mass of color in early summer, and continue to bloom right up until frost. The semi-double to double florets begin with creamy coloration in the center before maturing to intense pink. Flowers may shift to blue in acidic soils. Deciduous. Reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall and wide. Full to part sun Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, TWIST N SHOUT This reblooming lacecap Hydrangea inherited the best characteristics of both of its parents. Matures at 3 to 5 feet tall and 3 to 4 feet wide. Part shade Zone 4



HYDRANGEA, VAN. STRAW.

Large panicles emerge a creamy vanilla-white and mature through soft pink to strawberry red. A beautiful multi-color show. The large blooms are held erect on red stems. This dramatic Hydrangea grows 6 to 7 feet tall and 4 to 5 feet wide. Full sun to part sun Zone 4



HYDRANGEA, ZEBRA

Green flowers turn to white and measure 3.5 inches tall and 5.5 inches wide, and bloom all summer. The contrasting near-black stems provide a striking combination. **Grows to 4 feet tall and 3 feet wide**. Part shade Zone 5



HYDRANGEA, ZORRO

A fantastic new variety of Lacecap Hydrangea with spectacular large, deep blue or pink flowers carried on upright growing, dark (almost black) stems. **Grows 4 to 6 feet tall and wide.** Full sun to part shade Zone 5
