

## PERENNIALS

### **AJUGA, BUGUNDY GLOW**

Reddish purple foliage is variegated with white and pink. Fast growing and hardy. Grows 6" tall and is used for groundcover. Shade Zone 4-9



### **ALLIUM, MILLENIUM**

Compact upright clump of glossy, thick, green leaves with rose-purple ball clusters appearing just above the foliage on strong stems in mid to late summer. Easy to grow. Grows 20" tall with a 14" spread. Full sun Zone 5-9



### **ANEMONE, HONORINE**

A long blooming, large flowered Anemone with white blooms that exhibit pale pink on the backsides and yellow stamens. Bloom time is late summer to fall. Will grow to 36-42 inches tall. Sun to shade Zone 5



**ASTER, ALERT**

Plants form a bushy clump, bearing loads of small daisy flowers. This is a dwarf selection with double crimson-red blossoms. Grows 12" tall with an 18" spread. Full sun Zone 3-9



**ASTER, DREAM OF BEAUTY**

Masses of sugar-pink flowers accented by burnt orange centers adorn compact 15" tall by 2' wide plants. Another drought tolerant Aster that stars in the fall garden. Full sun Zone 4-7



**ASTER, NEW ENGLAND**

It is a stout, leafy plant typically growing 3-6' tall with a robust, upright habit. Features a profuse bloom of daisy-like asters (to 1.5" diameter) with purple rays and yellow centers from late summer to early fall. Full sun Zone 4-8



**ASTER, WUNDER VON STAFA** Features 2-3" diameter daisy-like flowers with lavender-blue rays and yellow centers. Flowers are borne in profusion on a compact, multi-stemmed plant typically growing to 2-3' tall with a loose, bushy, open habit. Flowers freely from early summer to early fall. Full sun to partial shade Zone 5-8



**ASTILBE, DEUTSCHLAND** Pure white, open, lacy, panicles dance above the flossy, deep green foliage. Attractive even when the plant is not in bloom. Great for brightening up shade gardens. Grows 2'-2.5' tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, FANAL** Blood red flowers are presented in upright spires. One of the earliest reds to bloom. Foliage is mahogany red in spring, turning green by summer. Vigorous grower. Grows to the height of 20". Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, MAGGIE**

Bright lavender purple plumes are dense and fussy. The shiny, dark green foliage is attractive even when the plant is not in bloom. Grows up to 28" tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, MONTGOMERY**

Dark magenta red, triangular shaped plumes are borne on darker red stems. Leaves emerge with a bronze red tint in spring, then turn dark green. Height up to 20-24". Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, PEACH BLOSSOM**

Delicate peach flowers with full plumes lend a frothy look to the clump. Glossy, green foliage. Grows to 2' tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, PURPLE CANDLES**

Dense, poker-like plumes emerge rich violet red, then lighten up as they age. Bold, dark green foliage with a coarse texture. Has a unique look; makes a strong color statement in the garden. Grows up to 3'-3.5' tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, RHEINLAND**

Clear rose-pink flowers are held in large, diamond-shaped panicles. Very floriferous and vigorous. Large, mid-green leaves. One of the best early pink Astilbes. Grows to 2' tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, SUPERBA**

Flower color is magenta to red-purple. Prefers deep rich soil with good moisture. Extend the bloom season by using this late bloomer. Grows 2'-3' tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, VISIONS**

Raspberry pink plumes are sweetly fragrant with a dense, pyramidal shape. Large, clear green leaves with a coarse texture form a robust clump. Grows to 14"-16' Tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTILBE, VIS. IN PINK**

Blooms are thick, upright and a pale pink in late spring/early summer. The foliage is an attractive blue green. This is a vigorous grower and will reach the height of 2.5'-3' tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**ASTIBLE, VIS. IN RED**

Deep red buds open to pinkish-red flowers on dense, fuzzy plumes. Red stems and bronze green foliage enhances the vibrant blossoms. Forms a robust clump. Grows up to 15" tall. Partial shade Zone 4-9



**BARRENWORT, MERLIN**

Pastel purple flowers from dark purple buds over bronze-infused leaves which mature light green. Clumping with moderate increase. Deer resistant. Great for groundcover. Shade Zone 5-8



**BARRENWORT, OR. QUEEN**

This has delightful light coppery-orange flowers that rise up in open clusters ahead of the new spring foliage. This variety is a slow spreader with medium green, heart shaped leaves growing 10" tall and 18 to 24" wide. Shade Zone 4-8



**BARRENWORT, SULPHUREUM**

This plant is a clumping barrenwort with short spurred, light yellow flowers that rise up above red tinted, heart shaped leaves in the spring. The flowers grow 12" tall and the clumps spread 15 to 18" wide. Spring blooms. Shade Zone 4-8



**BEARS BREECH**

This species forms a clump of huge, deeply-cut glossy green leaves, bearing upright spikes of hooded mauve-pink flowers in summer. Grows 59" tall with a 35" spread. Full sun to part shade Zone 7-9



**BEARDTONGUE, PR. SPLEND.**

Flat rosettes send up spikes to 2' in May, topped with very large, bell shaped flowers in shades of pink and light lavender. Full sun Zone 4-8



**BEARDTONGUE, PR. DUSK**

Plants form a low clump of green foliage, with upright spikes appearing in early summer. Flowers are vivid purple trumpets, attractive in the border and useful for cutting. Grows up to 2' tall. Full sun Zone 3-9



**BEE BALM, CORAL REEF**

Produces heads of large, shaggy deep-pink flowers in mid to late summer. Foliage is delightfully fragrant, and significantly more resistant to powdery mildew than most older varieties. Excellent for cutting. Grows to around 3' tall. Full sun to partial shade Zone 3-9



**BERGENIA, WINTER GLUT**

This is a large-leaved, clump-forming perennial that is primarily grown as a ground cover. It is noted for its dark rose pink flowers in April and its dark green leaves which turn purplish-bronze in winter. Grows to 1-1.5 tall and wide. Shade Zone 4-8



**BL. EYED SUSAN**

Black-eyed Susan is a flowering plant that grows over 3 feet tall. They have green leaves up to six inches long. Black-eyed Susan grows in open woods, gardens, fields, and roadsides. They grow quickly in just about any kind of soil. These plants are most easily recognized by their flowers. They have yellow flowers with a brownish-purple center. Black-eyed Susan bloom from June to October. Part sun to full sun. Zone 3-11



**BL EYED SUSAN, HIRTA**

It is a coarse, hairy, somewhat weedy plant that features daisy-like flowers with bright yellow to orange-yellow rays and domed, dark chocolate-brown center disks. Blooms throughout the summer atop stiff, leafy, upright stems growing 1-3' tall. Full sun Zone 3-7



**BL. EYED SUSAN, MISSOURI**

An upright, clump-forming, free-blooming coneflower which typically grows to 3' tall, often forming colonies in the wild. Features daisy-like flowers with yellow rays and brownish-purple center disks. Full sun Zone 3-9



**BLANK. FLOWER, A. APRICOT**

The compact, uniform mound of bright green foliage is covered in large blossoms from early summer into fall. The flowers are apricot with yellow tips and a darker orange center. Grows to 12" high and wide. Full sun Zone 3



**BLANK. FLOWER, AZ. SUN**

Large, 3-inch dark red flowers have ruffled yellow edges. Arizona Sun has a long flowering period, blooming from June to September. A compact and uniform plant, it will reach 8 to 10 inches tall with a spread of 10 to 12 inches. Full sun Zone 3



**BLAZING STAR, KOBOLD**

This blazing star cultivar is a small, compact, upright, clump-forming perennial which typically grows 2-2.5' tall. Features terminal, rounded, fluffy, deep purple flower heads appearing atop rigid, erect, leafy flower stalks. Blooms in summer. Full sun Zone 3-8



**BLEEDING HEART, FRING**

The leaves are deeply cut, grey green and fern like. The pink flowers are heart shaped with an inner petal that drips from the outer petals, creating the appearance that the heart is bleeding. Part shade Zone 3-9



**BLEEDING HEART, PINK**

Elegant plants growing 2 to 3 feet tall, have mounding fern-like leaves and arching sprays of red heart-shaped flowers from late spring to early summer. Best in fertile, light soil. Tolerates full sun in cooler climates. Sun to part shade Zone 2



**BLUE PLUMBAGO**

Spreading, low-growing groundcover with green, shiny foliage in late spring, turning bronze-red in fall. Deep blue flowers appear late summer to early fall on 8 to 12 inch plant. Sun Zone 3



**BRUNNERA, JACK FROST**

This shade loving perennial has silvery, heart-shaped foliage with dark green veining. A profusion of small, blue flowers bloom in early spring. Will reach 12 to 18 inches tall. Shade Zone 3



**BUGBANE, BRUNETTE**

Small, numerous, creamy white, strongly fragrant flowers appear in late summer to early fall in long, terminal racemes resembling fluffy spires rising well above the foliage on upright, wiry stems. It typically grows to 3-4' tall. Shade Zone 3-8



**BUGBANE, PINK SPIRE**

Pink Spire is a bugbane that grows to 2-4' tall and is noted for its bronze-purple foliage and late summer spikes of fragrant, pale pink flowers. The bottlebrush-like flower spikes are typically in bloom from late summer into fall atop dark upright stems rising above a clump of astilbe-like, ternate compound, deep bronze-purple leaves with serrated margins. Full to part shade Zone 4-8



**BUTTERFLY WEED, ORANGE**

Broad clusters of bright orange flowers occur in mid to late summer. Flower clusters are 2 to 5 inches across. Very attractive to butterflies, especially Monarchs. Sun Zone 4-9



**BUTTERFLY WD, SOUL MATE**

Broad clusters of deep rose-pink flowers occur in mid to late summer. Flower clusters are 2 to 5 inches across. Very attractive to butterflies, especially Monarchs. Sun Zone 4-9



**CANDYLILY, DAZZLER SER.**

Dazzler is a dwarf strain which features 6-petaled, saucer-shaped flowers in a variety of colors including yellow, orange, pink, purple and red growing to 16" tall. Flowers primarily bloom in July-August, with some sporadic continued bloom to frost. Each flower lasts only one day. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-9



**CATMINT, PURRSIAN**

It typically forms a spreading clump of decumbent, ascending and upright stems rising to 18-24" tall and spreading to as much as 36" wide. Gray-green leaves and lavender-blue flowers are highly aromatic. Full sun Zone 3-8



**CATMINT, WALKERS LOW**

Blue-purple flower spikes sprout forth profusely from late spring to early fall on this low billowing, aromatic, and sun-loving perennial. Foliage is gray-green and has a distinctive catmint scent. It matures at 14 inches tall and 2 feet wide. The plant is ideal for the herb garden or flowerbed border with its billowing habit. Full sun Zone 4



**CLEMATIS, COMTESSE DE B.**

Comtesse de Bouchard is a classic late-flowering clematis. Raised in France back in 1900, it holds its own among modern varieties, producing bright mauve-pink flowers with cream anthers from mid-summer to early autumn. Can grow 6-8' tall. Full sun to part shade. Zone 4-9



**CLEMATIS, ERNEST MARK**

Ernest Markham is a vigorous, late-flowering climber with abundant small flowers in summer. Blossoms are rich magenta, 4 inches across, with blunt-tipped sepals and light chocolate anthers. Can grow up to 15' tall. Full sun Zone 3-9



**CLEMATIS, MISS BATEMAN**

Miss Bateman is an extremely early bloomer and is in addition noteworthy for her overall excellence as a garden plant. She is compact to 8', with 4- 6" flowers of a creamy white with chocolate-red stamens. Sun to part shade Zone 5-9



**CLEMATIS, PRINCE CHARLES**

Prince Charles has 4 inch mauve blue blooms with yellow anthers. The semi-nodding flowers are deeply ribbed with a slight twisting habit, standing 6-8 foot tall. Enjoy the incredible flower power and beauty of Prince Charles from July through September. Full sun to part shade  
Zone 4-9



**COLUMBINE, BLUE JAY**

Medium-compact perennial with an eye-catching bloom. Blooms in late spring and early summer. Large, beautiful, light blue and white flowers. Grows to the height of 11" tall. Partial shade Zone 3-9



**COLUMBINE, CRIMSON STAR**

This selection features bright crimson-red flowers with a white center, over a compact mound of ferny light-green foliage. Excellent for cutting and is self-sowing. Could grow up to 2.5' tall. Partial shade Zone 3-9



**COMFREY, GRANDIFLORUM**

Comfrey is generally a coarse, hairy, perennial that is typically grown in borders and shade gardens. It typically forms a low-spreading foliage clump to 18" tall consisting of both ascending flowering stems. Tubular, bluebell-like, creamy yellow to white flowers appear in drooping clusters in mid-spring to early summer. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-8



**COMFREY, HIDCOTE BLUE**

Hidcote Blue is a hybrid comfrey cultivar that typically grows in a low-spreading clump to 18" tall. It features light green crinkled leaves. Bell-shaped, bluebell-like, soft blue and white flowers appear in drooping clusters in mid-spring to early summer. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-8



**CONEFLOWER, ALOHA**

Wide, melon-yellow petals surround orange cones on this summer to frost bloomer. A very welcoming and elegant plant that greets you with its fragrance and beauty. A standout in our garden. Will grow up to 32" tall with a 28" spread. Full sun Zone 4-10



**CONEFLOWER, CHEY. SPIRIT**

A mix of pink, red, yellow, orange, purple and white 3 to 3.5-inch blooms flower at different heights from mid-summer to early fall. A well-branched, upright growth habit reaches 2 feet tall and wide. Great for landscapes or cut flowers. Full sun Zone 4



**CONEFLOWER, HARV. MOON**

Huge, 4 inch wide, golden yellow blooms have overlapping petals and a bold orange cone. Another Big Sky series coneflower. Grows to 24 to 29 inches tall with an 18 inch spread. Full sun Zone 5



**CONEFLOWER, HOT PAPAYA**

Orange to red-orange 3 to 3.5-inch skirted pompom flowers bloom on strong stems and have color that does not fade. Very floriferous and vigorous plant that forms a strong sturdy clump growing 30 to 36 inches tall and 24 to 30 inches wide. Full sun Zone 4



**CONEFLOWER, HOT SUMMER** Striking flowers display unique colors as they open yellow and steadily turn to scarlet-red as they mature. This creates a mix of colors in shades of yellow, red, and orange. Grows to 24-30 inches tall. Sun to part shade Zone 5



**CONEFLOWER, MAGNUS** Extra large, purple-rose, daisy-like flowers with a center cone on 3-foot tall stems from late spring through summer. Great sun-loving and drought tolerant perennial. Attracts butterflies! Stunning with Ornamental Grasses. Full sun Zone 4



**CONEFLOWER, POW WOW** A profusely flowering Coneflower with unique, large, deep magenta flower petals surrounding a darker cone. Sturdy stems make for great cut flowers. Grows 20 to 24 inches tall. Drought tolerant. Great for landscapes. Full sun Zone 4



**CONEFLOWER, POW. BERRY**

Large 3" fragrant blooms flower earlier than most Echinacea and continue reblooming well into early fall. Deep rose purple blooms are fade-proof and stay attractive as a fresh picked summer berry. Charming and compact at only 24" tall with sturdy branching which means lots of blooms that hold up nicely even under adverse weather conditions. Full sun Zone 3-8



**CONEFLOWER, ROCKY TOP**

Rocky top is a Tennessee coneflower seed cultivar that typically grows to a compact 24-30" tall. It features daisy-like coneflowers with well-spaced, upward-turned pink rays and black central cones. Flowers bloom from June to August with some sporadic later bloom. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-8



**CONEFLOWER, SOLAR FLARE**

The flowers are large, single and fragrant with petals a deep magenta-red surrounding a dark cone. As the flowers mature, they fade to an attractive smoky-rose. Coneflowers begin blooming in midsummer. Grows to the height of 2.5' tall. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-9



**CONEFLOWER, SUNDOWN**

Strikingly bold orange coneflower with a prominent brown cone. Slightly taller than the Big Sky Sunset variety, Sundown will reach a height of 32 to 36 inches tall with an 18 inch spread. Smells wonderful and is a butterfly magnet. Full sun Zone 5



**CONEFLOWER, SUNRISE**

The citron yellow, daisy-like blossom has a prominent, central cone that starts out green and turns to gold. It has fuller, toothed leaves and wide, overlapping flower petals. Grows to 30-36 inches. Full sun Zone 4



**CONEFLOWER, VIRGIN**

Virgin is a compact white-flowered coneflower that grows in an upright clump to 18-24" tall and to 12-18" wide on sturdy, well-branched stems that do not need staking. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-8



**CONEFL, POW WOW WHITE**

A profusely flowering Coneflower with unique large, white flower petals surrounding a yellow center. Sturdy stems make for great cut flowers. Grows 20 to 24 inches tall. Drought tolerant. Great for landscapes. Full sun Zone 4



**COREOPSIS, AMER. DREAM**

American Dream is a cultivar which typically grows in dense, bushy clumps to 18" tall. Features daisy-like flowers with pink rays and yellow center disks. Full sun Zone 3-9



**COREOPSIS, EARLY SUNRISE**

Early Sunrise is a compact cultivar which features solitary, yellow, daisy-like, semi-double flowers with yellow rays and darker yellow center disks atop slender, erect stems rising to 18" tall. Flowers typically bloom from late spring to late summer and sometimes well into fall. Full sun Zone 4-9



**COREOPSIS, HEAVEN GATE**

Heaven's Gate is noted for its profuse summer bloom of flowers in bicolor shades of pink and red or in a single shades of dark red. Each daisy-like flower typically features rose pink petals with a darker rose-red petal ring surrounding a golden center. This is a cultivar that typically grows in dense, bushy clumps to 8-15" tall and to as much as 24" wide. Full sun Zone 5-8



**COREOPSIS, LIL BANG**

Coreopsis Li'l Bang Daybreak has a very compact habit with explosive blooms. The bright flowers are single with red centers and yellow and orange around the edges. Flowers are long lasting, beginning in the summer and continuing into the fall. Grows 6-10" tall with an 18" spread. Full sun Zone 5-9



**COREOPSIS, MARMALADE**

Stunning flowers of this variety open deep orange in spring, then mellow to soft apricot yellow into summer. Under very high temperatures, the color can become bright yellow. Grows to 12" tall. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-9



**COREOPSIS, SIENNA SUNSET**

Sienna Sunset is a threadleaf-type coreopsis that typically grows in a clump to 16-20" tall spreading to 20-24" wide. Daisy-like flowers bloom from late spring to mid-summer with sporadic additional into fall. Full sun Zone 5-9



**COREOPSIS, SWEET DREAM**

Raspberry-white, bi-color, daisy-like flowers cover the foliage mound in a profuse and lengthy summer bloom. Grows in dense, bushy clumps to 18" tall and 24" wide. Full sun Zone 4-9



**COREOPSIS, ZAGREB**

Features bright yellow, daisy-like flowers with untoothed rays and darker yellow center disks. Flowers appear singly in loose clusters in a lengthy late spring to late summer bloom. Grows in dense, bushy clumps to 1-3' tall and is more compacted. Full sun Zone 3-9



**DAISY, BECKY**

A profusion of large, single white flowers with bright yellow centers appear on stems 36 inches above the dense, green clumping foliage. Flower heads hold up extremely well after a heavy rain. Blooms abundantly from summer to fall if deadheaded. It's perfect as a cut flower. Full sun Zone 5



### **DAISY, SHASTA**

Bushy, compact, upright plants 12"-3 feet in height. Easy to grow perennial. Attractive plants for borders and flowers are especially good in arrangements. The Shasta daisy comes into bloom in June and July and will continue giving bloom through August if faded flowers are removed. Full sun Zone 5-8



### **DAISY, THOMAS KILLEN**

Thomas Killen Shasta Daisy features beautiful white daisy flowers with yellow eyes at the ends of the stems from early to late summer, which are most effective when planted in groupings. Will grow to be about 24" tall at maturity extending to 3 feet tall with the flowers, with a spread of 2". Full sun to part sun Zone 4



### **DAYLILY, HAPPY RETURNS**

Happy Returns is a repeat-blooming diploid cultivar which features 3.5" diameter, ruffled, lemon yellow flowers on naked stems typically rising to 18" tall above a clump of arching, linear, blade-like leaves. Individual flowers open for one day. Mildly fragrant. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-9



### **DAYLILY, HYPERION**

Disease-free perennial is excellent for slopes, massing, edgings and foundations. Showy, sweet smelling, lemon-yellow, 5-inch blooms. Large clumps of long, grass-like leaves are highlighted by lily-like flowers on tall stems. Foliage to 18 in. high, 3 ft. wide; flower stalks 3 ft. tall. Full sun Zone 4-11



### **DAYLILY, PARDON ME**

They form dense clumps of grassy foliage, with upright stems of trumpet flowers. This fragrant selection features small cranberry-red flowers with a yellow throat. Midseason. Repeat bloomer. Grows 18" tall with a 28" spread. Full sun to part shade Zone 2-9



### **DAYLILY, ROSY RETURN**

Rosy Returns is a dwarf, ever blooming daylily that typically grow to 12-14" tall. Rose-pink flowers appear in clusters in summer that rise slightly above the foliage. Each flower is rose-pink with a deeper rose eye zone and a yellow throat. Flowers bloom from late May through September. Flowers are fragrant. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-9



**DAYLILY, RUBY STELLA**

Ruby Stella Daylily features bold ruby-red trumpet-shaped flowers at the ends of the stems from early to late summer. The flowers are excellent for cutting. It's grassy leaves remain green in color throughout the season. Grows to the height of 26" tall with an 18" spread. Full to part sun Zone 2-9



**DAYLILY, STELLA D'ORO**

Stella de Oro daylily is valued as a compact plant and early bloomer, reaching a height of just 12" with a similar spread. It blooms from May-July. Full sun Zone 3-9



**DIANTHUS, COCONUT PUNCH**

Large, fragrant, double blossoms open deep red with white markings in the center of each petal. As they mature, the white expands and red lightens, leaving a wine colored ring around each petal. Grows to 12" in height. Full sun Zone 4-8



**DIANTHUS, COCONUT SURP.**

Bearing pure white, full double blossoms on strong stems surrounded by silvery-blue foliage, the "surprise" is the burgundy-red splash of color at the center of this gorgeous bloom.. Very fragrant. Grows up 12" high and wide. Full sun Zone 5-9



**DIANTHUS, FIREWITCH**

Fragrant, magenta pink blossoms are produced prolifically over low, silvery blue mats of evergreen foliage. Often reblooms in fall. Full to part sun Zone 3-9



**DIANTHUS, FROSTY FIRE**

Double, Chinese lacquer-red blooms explode above mounds of icy blue-green, evergreen foliage. May rebloom in fall. Full to part sun Zone 3-9



**DIANTHUS, HEART ATTACK**

A long-lived beauty! The original plant is over 15 years old and is beautiful. Brick red flowers blanket the dark green, glossy foliage in spring. Will grow to 15 inches tall and 2 feet wide. A cold hardy and heat tolerant selection. Full sun Zone 4



### **DWARF GOATS BEARD**

A diminutive habit and handsome creamy white flower spikes reminiscent of a goat's beard make this refined clumping version a necessity for the mixed border where nobody will butt heads. Unlike other family members, this selection grows to a mere 12 inches tall. Shade to part shade Zone 3-7



### **FALSE INDIGO**

Blue false indigo is an upright perennial which typically grows 3-4' tall. It features purple, lupine-like flowers in erect racemes atop flower spikes extending well above a foliage mound of clover-like, bluish-green leaves. Blooms in spring. Full sun to part shade zone 3-9



### **FALSE INDIGO, TWILIGHT**

Twilight produces almost 100 flower spikes of unique deep violet-purple flowers highlighted by a lemon-yellow keel. Held above the handsome blue-green foliage, the inflorescences can be up to 32 inches long. Grows to the height of 5' tall with a 3' spread. Full to part sun Zone 4-8



**FERN, AUTUMN**

A colorful fern with reddish fronds when young, maturing to a deep dark green, deeply cut. It slowly grows to a height of 2 feet and spreads to 2 feet wide. Loves shade and needs constantly moist soil. Shade Zone 5



**FERN, BRILLIANCE**

A beautiful specimen for shade loving gardens/landscape. Green showy bi-pinnate fronds. At maturity this fern forms a tapestry of glossy green vase shape. Mainly used for groundcover but is drought tolerant once established. Shade Zone 5



**FERN, CHRISTMAS**

Christmas fern typically grows in a fountain-like clump to 2' tall and features leathery, lance-shaped, evergreen (green at Christmas time) fronds. Crosiers (young fiddleheads) in spring are silvery and scaled. Evergreen fronds provide good winter interest for the landscape. Shade Zone 3-9



### **FERN, CINNAMON**

Cinnamon fern typically grows in clumps to 2-3' tall, but with constant moisture can reach 5' in height. Separate spore-bearing, stiff, fertile fronds appear in early spring, quickly turning brown. The familiar "fiddleheads" also emerge from the base of the plant and unfurl into large, erect, pinnately-compound, yellowish-green, sterile fronds which remain attractive throughout the summer and turn yellow in autumn. Shade Zone 3-9



### **FERN, GHOST**

Frosted apple green fronds emit a ghostly white light in the shade. Dark purple stems hold the broad fronds rigidly upright. This election is taller than many other ferns. Shade Zone 3-8



### **FERN, HAY SCENTED**

Excellent fern for naturalizing due to the long creeping rhizomes that allow this fern to rapidly spread and produce patches of foliage instead of clumps. Works very well for woodland garden settings ranging from light shade to deep shade conditions. Grows 2-3' tall and grows quickly. Shade Zone 4-9



**FERN, JAPANESE PAINTED**

A striking deciduous Fern that grows 18 to 24 inches tall and wide. Stems are burgundy with fronds tinged blue and silver. A very hardy Fern that is easy to grow. Use as a groundcover or an accent plant. Can also be used in borders and containers. It is deer and rabbit resistant. Shade Zone 3



**FERN, OSTRICH**

Ostrich fern is a clump-forming, upright to arching, deciduous fern which typically grows 2-3' tall. The showy parts of this fern are the finely dissected, medium green, vegetative fronds which exhibit the feathery appearance of long ostrich plumes. The vegetative fronds emerge at the narrow base of the clumps in spring as the familiar "fiddleheads" from where they unfurl to a maximum length of 4'. Full shade Zone 3-7



**FOXGLOVE, STRAWBERRY**

Tall spires of strawberry pink tubular flowers attract hummingbirds. Quick to re-bloom if old flowers are cut promptly. Essential for the lightly shaded border, or in woodlands or under trees. Excellent cut flower. Hardy perennial. Fast growth to about 2- 3' tall or more in bloom, and 2' wide. Part sun Zone 3-9
