## **GAURA, CRIMSON BUTTER**

Has wispy, dark crimson, willow-like foliage. Butterfly-like hot pink flowers bloom atop 24-inch tall red stems from spring to autumn. Compact and drought, heat and high humidity tolerant. Full sun Zone 5



#### **GAURA, WHIRLING BUTTER**

This gaura cultivar is a compact, clump-forming, vase-shaped perennial with wiry, arching red stems, pink flower buds and 4-petaled snow white flowers which appear in long, terminal, wand-like panicles above the foliage over a very long late spring to autumn bloom period.

Typically grows 2-3' tall. Full sun Zone 5-9



#### **GERANIUM, DARK REITER**

A beautiful mounding Geranium with finely dissected reddish-purple foliage. Deep blue-purple flowers in summer. Grows 8-10 inches tall with a 10-12 inch spread. Partial shade Zone 4



## **GERANIUM, DRAGON HEART**

Dragon Heart is a large geranium that typically grows in a clump to 12-18" tall, but sends out sprawling stems that weave through the garden. Five-petaled magenta flowers with black centers and attractive deep red veining bloom from late spring to September. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-8



#### **GERANIUM, JOHNSON BLUE**

Johnson's Blue is one of the most popular blue-flowered geraniums. It is a perennial that typically grows in a dense spreading mound to 12-18" tall and to 24-30" wide. Large, saucer-shaped, sky blue flowers bloom in clusters above the foliage from late spring to early fall. Deeply cut dark green foliage. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-8



## **GERANIUM, MAX FREI**

Max Frei' is a hardy geranium cultivar that is noted for its compact growth habit and reddish-purple flowers. It typically forms a spreading mound of foliage typically growing 4-9" tall and spreading 12-24" wide. It features 5-petaled, reddish-purple flowers and deeply-lobed, dark green leaves. Primarily blooms in May and June with a sparser rebloom occurring throughout the summer. Foliage often turns attractive shades of red in autumn. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-8



## **GERANIUM, NEW HAMSHIRE**

This hardy geranium cultivar is a clump-forming perennial which forms a spreading mound of foliage that typically grows to 12" tall but spreads to 18" wide. Features 5-petaled, deep magenta flowers and deeply-lobed, dark green leaves. Primarily blooms in May and June in hot summer climates. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-8



#### **GOATSBEARD**

A tall, erect, bushy, clump-forming plant typically growing 4-6' high which features pinnately compound, dark green foliage and showy, plume-like spikes of tiny, cream colored flowers which rise well above the foliage in early to mid summer, creating a bold effect. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-8



**HELLEBORE, HYBRID** 

Hybrid hellebore is a welcome late winter bloomer. It flowers from January to April, depending on the region, with tall flower stems arising from the center of the plant. The cup shaped, nodding or outward facing flowers last up to two months. Its foliage grows as a clump of leathery, evergreen leaves. The hybrid hellebores now come in a wide range of colors, including white, cream, yellow, pink, rose, red and purple. Can grow up to 1 ½' tall. Part shade Zone 5-9



**HELLEBORE, JACOB** 

Single, pure white blooms turn light green as flowers age. Cool weather can produce pink-tinged flowers. Handsome dark green foliage. First-year blooming. Grows to 9-12" tall. Shade Zone 4



**HELLEBORE, ROYAL HERITAGE** It is a collection of hybrids with a wide variety of flower colors including tones and combinations of purples, reds, near-blacks, whites, greens and pinks. Nodding, cup-shaped, rose-like flowers with overlapping petals and center crowns of conspicuously contrasting yellow stamens appear in clusters at the tips of leafy stems from early February through April. Bloom period can be longer in mild winters. These plants are bushy, clump-forming perennials that typically grow 18-24" tall. Shade Zone 4-9



#### **HEUCHERA, BERRY SMOOTH**

Berry Smoothie is a clump-forming coral bells hybrid. It is noted for its rose pink leaves that gradually darken with age to purple-pink. Foliage retains good color throughout the growing season. Foliage typically forms a basal mound to 12-18" tall and to 12-18" wide. Small, soft pink flowers borne in open, airy panicles appear in late spring to early summer on slender, wiry stems rising above the foliage mound, typically to 24-28" tall. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-8



## **HEUCHERA, CARAMEL**

This Coral Bells has rich, honey-apricot leaves that grow 10 to 16 inches tall and 18 inches wide. This variety has excellent heat and humidity tolerance in the south and sun tolerance in cool northern gardens. Partial shade Zone 4



# **HEUCHERA, CHRISTA**

Christa is a vigorous, clump-forming, compact coral bells cultivar that features rose-purple leaves with a peach underlay. Leaves turn peach with a silvery sheen as they mature. The lobed, rounded leaves form a basal mound to 8-10" tall and as wide. Tiny, bell-shaped, pink flowers appear in spires in summer on slender stems rising above the foliage mound to 10-12" tall. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-9



## **HEUCHERA, CITRONELLA**

Citronelle is a vigorous, clump-forming, compact coral bells cultivar that features cordate yellow-green leaves on rosy red petioles. The lobed, crenate, rounded leaves form a basal mound which may spread to 14" wide. Tiny, creamy white flowers appear in spires in summer on slender stems rising above the foliage mound, typically to 10-12" tall. Sun to part shade Zone 4-8



# **HEUCHERA, CIRCUS**

Magenta flowers complement the large, chartreuse to medium green leaves and deep maroon veining during the spring, while excellent late-season foliage color ranges from green to yellows and pinks. Can grow to the height of 12-18". Full shade to part sun. Zone 4-8



## **HEUCHERA, CHRISTA**

# **HEUCHERA, GALAXY**

Variegated foliage of dark red with pink spots. Foliage emerges bright red in spring and darkens by summer, as the leaves darken the lighter pink spots become more prominent. Very heat and humidity tolerant, white flowers bloom early summer. Grows to the height of 10" tall. Shade to part sun. Zone 4-9



## **HEUCHERA, GEORGIA PEACH**

Spectacular glowing peach colored leaves with alight silver overlay measuring up to 8" across give this plant incredible impulse appeal.

Makes a fantastic specimen in containers and in the landscape. Creamy white flowers. Grows up to 14". Shade to part sun Zone 4-9



## **HEUCHERA, LEMON CHIFFON**

A mounding variety with bright chartreuse foliage that grows 10-12 inches tall. Bloom is a lighter pink to white flower. Heucheras beautiful foliage gives excellent garden color all season long. Shade to part sun Zone 4-9



**HEUCHERA, MARV. MARBLES** Spring foliage emerges in tones of purple, summer brings green leaves with prominent red-purple veining and a silvery blush. Flower stems are held tighter to the foliage than other species, reaching just 8 inches above the leaves producing flowers in tones of creamy white. Marvelous Marble blooms a bit earlier than other Heuchera. Foliage reaches 12" tall. Full sun to full shade. Zone 3-9



## **HEUCHERA, MIDNIGHT ROSE**

This unique coral bell has deep purple-black leaves that are splashed with hot pink in spring. As the season progresses, the spots lighten to a creamy pink. Midnight Rose's foliage reaches 10" in height. Shade to part sun. Zone 4-9



#### **HEUCHERA, OBSIDIAN**

Deep purplish black leaves have a polished glassy luster like that of its namesake. Undersides are shiny and deep purple. Forms a compact, tight mound. Ideal for edging or containers. Smoky purple buds and cream flowers. Grows to the height of 10" tall. Shade Zone 4-9



#### **HEUCHERA, PALACE PURPLE**

Large, shiny, star shaped leaves range in color from deep olive green to purplish-bronze with amethyst purple undersides. Tiny cream colored flowers that the foliage grows to the height of 12" tall. Shade Zone 4-9



## **HEUCHERA, PEACH PARFAIT**

Peach Parfait pops in the shade with eye-catching, slightly ruffled peachy foliage touched by deep orange veining and silver highlights. Does exceptionally well with the heat and humidity. An excellent addition to a shady garden or mixed container. 10-12" in height. Full shade. Zone 4-9



# **HEUCHERA, PL. PUDDING**

Plum Pudding is a hybrid coral bells cultivar. It is a clump-forming perennial which features large, shiny, silvery, plum-purple leaves with dark-purple veining and conspicuous but non-showy whitish flowers. Tiny whitish flowers borne in open, airy panicles appear in late spring to early summer on slender wiry stems rising well above the foliage mound typically to 26" tall. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-9



## **HEUCHERA, VENUS**

Venus displays large, silvery foliage with deep green veining. Near white flowers appear above the foliage in late spring. Will reach 15" tall. Makes a great groundcover and is perfect for edging and borders. Part shade. Zone 4-9



# **HEUCHERA, WATERMELON**

Wonderful shades of peaches, pinks and greens grace this compact variety's foliage, with hints of bright pink popping from the undersides of the leaves. Grows to the height of 10-12" tall. Full shade Zone 4-9



## **HEUCHERELLA, CHRISTA**

Distinctive, peachy orange coloring and compact growth habit. This lovely heuchera emerges with young leaves that are rose purple with a peach underlay, and matures to display peachy orange color. Pink flowers on 12-14" scapes in mid-summer. Sun to part shade Zone 4-9



# **HIBISCUS, FANTASIA**

Fantasia is a beautiful compact, vigorous, sturdy hibiscus that typically grows 2-3' tall and features dinner plate-sized, ruffled flowers which are among the largest flowers produced by any perennial. Flowers are rosy pink with a dark rosy red central eye. Full sun Zone 4-9



## HIBISCUS, KOPPER KING

A compact plant that reaches 4 feet tall and wide with copper-red, foliage. Creamy-pink flowers appear all summer with a bright red eye that streaks through the petals, and is up to 12 inches wide. Full sun Zone 4



# **HIBISCUS, LUNA PINK SWIRL**

Large, 6 to 8 inch across, eye-catching pink flowers with dark cranberry-red eyes bloom from mid-summer to frost. Well-branched, this plant will grow 2 to 3 feet tall with a spread of 3 feet. Great for containers or planting at water's edge. Full sun Zone 5



## **HIBISCUS, LUNA RED**

Deep burgundy-red, 7 to 8-inch, showy flowers proliferate on this big, bushy, and well-branched plant. Will reach 2 to 3 feet tall with an equal spread at maturity. A heat tolerant plant that is drought resistant once established. Full sun Zone 5



# **HIBISCUS, PLUM CRAZY**

A vigorous rounded shrub-like plant growing to 4 feet tall and wide. Has maple leaf-like, plum colored foliage. Large, 10-inch, lavender blooms with darker purple veins cover the plant from mid to late summer. Full sun Zone 4



## **HOSTA, BLUE UMBRELLA**

This is an immense hosta growing to 36" high and 48" in diameter. Features large, heart-shaped, thick-textured, corrugated, blue-green leaves with bell-shaped, white flowers up to 42". Grown primarily for its beautiful foliage which provides color, contrast and texture to the landscape. Shade Zone 3-8



## **HOSTA, BIG DADDY**

Classic award winning blue hosta. Forms a large, upright, compact clump of thick, rounded chalky blue leaves. Foliage becomes puckered and cupped as it matures and deepens to blue green as summer progresses. Near white, bell-shaped flowers. Shade Zone 4



# **HOSTA, BLUE ANGEL**

Large blue-leaved, giant-sized clump of striking, deep blue foliage and attractive clusters of near-white flowers make this plant worth leaving space for in the garden. Mounding to 32 inches high by 70 inches wide. Partial shade Zone 3



# **HOSTA, EARTH ANGEL**

Plants form sturdy mounds of foliage, topped with lily-like blooms. This spectacular large specimen selection has thick blue-green leaves with a wide and streaky margin of light yellow to creamy white. Lavender flowers appear in June. Grows up to 35" tall to 59" wide. Part shade Zone 2-9



#### **HOSTA, FRANCEE**

Francee is a medium-sized Hosta that grows 2 feet tall and 4 feet wide. Wonderful white margins contrast with the green heart-shaped leaves. It produces lavender flowers in late summer and performs well in sun or shade. Prefers partial shade Zone 3



# **HOSTA, GREAT EXPECT.**

Expect great slug and sunburn resistance on this center-variegated, Elegans type, mounding, shade-loving perennial. Slightly puckered, deep blue-green, oval leaves feature creamy-yellow centers. Matures at 28 inches tall and 30 inches wide. Partial shade Zone 4



## **HOSTA, GUACOMOLE**

An exciting, large mound of chartreuse-centered foliage, producing large fragrant flowers in late summer. Grows 16 to 24 inches high and up to 36 to 54 inches wide. Excellent for containers and woodland gardens. Part shade Zone 4



**HOSTA, HALCYON** 

Mid-sized blue hosta with a long season of appeal. Leaves are frosty blue-green and pointed. Foliage has a heavy substance and is slug resistant. Pale blue-violet flowers. Partial shade Zone 4



**HOSTA, KROSSA REGAL** 

A superb regal Hosta with huge silver-blue foliage becoming more green with maturity. Lavender flowers in mid-summer on stalks 4 to 5 feet tall. Upright and spreading shape maturing at 2 feet tall and wide. Excellent in landscape or container. Partial shade Zone 3



**HOSTA, LOYALIST** 

A sport of 'Patriot' Loyalist is considered to be one of the best white centered hostas ever. A medium sized hosta with a wide white center and dark green margins. A vigorous hosta with great substance. Grows 24" tall and 18" wide. Partial shade Zone 3



## **HOSTA, MINUTEMAN**

Has the widest, whitest, cleanest edging on a Hosta. Matures at 18 to 22 inches tall and 36 inches wide. This is a good plant for groundcover, edging, accent plantings, and containers. Perfect for formal and informal designs. Partial shade Zone 4



## HOSTA, PARADIGM

Thick, corrugated, gold leaves with jetting blue-green margins; variegation intensifies later in the spring. Light lavender flowers. Partial shade Zone 4



## **HOSTA, PATRIOT**

Patriot is a hosta cultivar that features a 12-20" tall mound of large, variegated, oval, basal leaves which have deep green centers and wide irregular white margins. Foliage mound will typically spread to 24-30" wide. Racemes of bell-shaped, lavender flowers appear in summer on scapes rising well above the foliage mound to 34" tall. Full to part shade Zone 3-8



#### **HOSTA, PAUL'S GLORY**

Blue to dark green leaf margin contrasts beautifully with the gold center, which begins the season chartreuse. Pale lavender, bell-shaped flowers appear on 40-inch stems in mid-summer. This moderate grower mounds to 25 inches high and 55 inches wide. Partial shade Zone 3



#### **HOSTA, SIEBODIANA**

Huge glue-gray, rounded leaves measure 10x9 inches. They become heavily textured and corrugated as they mature. Best blue leaf color is achieved in light shade. White flowers. Partial shade Zone 4



#### **HOSTA, STAINED GLASS**

This midsized specimen selection has bright golden-yellow leaves with a wide, streaky green margin. Pale lavender flowers appear in August. Some direct sun will bring out the best possible color. 20" tall with a 45" spread. Part sun to shade Zone 2-9



#### **HOSTA, SUM & SUBSTANCE**

This largest Hosta cultivar features an immense mound of light green to chartreuse to medium gold foliage depending on light level. Pale lavender flowers on 48" spikes adorn this 30" high by 70" wide specimen. Partial shade Zone 3



## **HOSTA, TRIFECTA**

This miniature selection has heart-shaped white leaves, edged in green with some chartreuse streaking. Lavender flowers appear in July. Perfect for the rock garden, containers or edging. 4-6" in height. Full to part shade. Zone 2-9



# **HOSTA, WIDE BRIM**

This medium-sized selection has green leaves with a streaky ivory to creamy-yellow margin. Pale lavender flowers appear in July. Grows up to 18" tall with a 40" spread. Shade Zone 2-9



# HYSSOP, CANA

Tubular, sweetly fragrant, purple flowers arranged in whorls on erect, salvia-like, terminal and axillary spikes. Flowers appear over a long June to September bloom period. This is a compact, uniformly-branched, woody-based perennial with an upright habit, typically growing to 16" tall and as wide. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-9



## **HYSSOP, PURPLE HAZE**

This plant has a vibrant violet purple flower that looks like spikes. It forms a sizable upright clump of aromatic blue-green foliage that does not require staking. Very long blooming flowers that bloom for months beginning in mid-summer. Grows up to 3' tall. Full sun to part shade Zone 6-9



# HYSSOP, ROSIE POSIE

Rosie Posie is dense and compact, with a nicely rounded habit. The blooms are held right at the tips of the stems, for maximum effectiveness, and they sport a good-looking two-tone cast, thanks to deep purple calyces surrounding the hot pink flowers. Rosie Posie reaches 22 inches high and 32 inches wide. Full sun Zones 4-9



# **HYSSOP, TANGO**

Trumpet shaped blooms of sizzling hot red orange. Compact habit is perfect for herb gardens. Tango will look great with Salvia or Lavender. Extremely long blooming perennial with oodles of charming blooms. Grows 12-18" tall and blooms all summer into fall. Full sun Zone 5-10
