ICE PLANT, FIRE SPINNER

This beautiful plant will spread up to about a foot and a half wide within just 2 seasons of growth. When not in bloom, the small, needle-like succulent foliage of brightest green reaches just 1 to 2 inches high. When the gorgeous multi-colored 1½-inch flowers begin appearing, the height increases to just 4 inches! Yet this plant forms a dense, colorful mat that chokes out weeds and retains soil moisture beautifully. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-10



IRIS WATER, YELLOW FLAG

Beautiful bright yellow flowers, with a darker yellow zone and brown or violet veining on each fall, bloom in late spring to early summer on rigid, upright, branched stalks. It grows in expanding clumps to 3-4' tall and to 30" wide. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-9



IRIS, CAESAR'S BROTHER

This tall Siberian iris produces deep purple flowers in late spring on rigid stems which rise to 40" high above a clump of arching, narrow, grass-like, linear leaves. Clumps will grow together and snuff out weeds. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-8



IRIS, AZUMA KAGAMI

The Japanese irises offer the largest flowers of all iris groups with very interesting color combinations. They prefer full sun and moist soil. Azuma Kagami has bluish white flowers with fine, lilac veins and purple stamens. Full sun Zone 4-9



IRIS, BEARDED, ASSTD. VAR.

Bearded Iris are identified by the conspicuous "beards" on each of the falls of the blossoms. Bearded Iris offers an astounding array of colors and color combinations blooming in your garden from early spring to early summer. They grow with an average height of 2.5' tall. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-8



IRIS, BOLD PRETENDER

Blooming reliably each year, huge 4-6" blossoms open flat to display their salmon orange blooms with the narrowest gold signal on each petal. The bloom time varies by climate, but typically ranges from late spring into midsummer. Grows to about 3' tall. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-10



IRIS, DWARF CRESTED

This dwarf crested iris is a low-growing, rapidly spreading plant that typically grows to 3-6" tall. It features pale blue, lilac or lavender iris flowers with gold crests on the falls. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-9



IRIS, EDEN'S HARMONY

The blooms are 6-9 in. across and appear in June in a wide range of colors. Adapts well to full sun or partial shade and moist soils. Ideal for use near the edge of a water garden or in water to 1 in. deep. White with a bluish to pink blush. Stamens pure white. Grows to 34" in height. Full sun Zone 5



IRIS, EDEN'S PURPLE GLORY

Adapts well to moist soils. Ideal for use near the edge of a water garden or in water to 1 in. deep. Deep blue with narrow yellow mark near throat. Stamens purple. Grows to 34" in height. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



IRIS, HURRICANE PARTY

Lightly ruffled full red violet, slightly darker around large triangular yellow gold signal and down center of falls. Cream styles shading to full dark red violet; slight fragrance. Grows to 39" in height. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



IRIS, JAPANESE

Japanese iris is a beardless perennial iris that grows in slowly expanding clumps to 2-4' tall. Cultivars come in single, double and peony flowered forms in a wide range of colors including shades of blue, lavender, violet-red, pink and white. Blooms early to mid-summer. Full sun to part shade Zone 4



IRIS, SEA KNIGHT

Very dark blue, orange line signal. Can grow to the height 20-25 inches. Early to mid-season. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-9.



IRIS, SHIRLEY POPE

Ruffled, semi-flaring blooms are very dark purple with a breath of red and a black velvet sheen. A prominent white signal veined with purplenavy shines from the center of the flower. 30" in height. Sun to part shade Zone 3-9



JACOBS LADDER, HEAVENLY

A variegated Jacob's Ladder with medium green foliage edged in creamy white. Edging has a lovely pink flush in cool weather. Fragrant, blue flowers sit atop the foliage in mid to late spring. Grows 10 to 12 inches tall. Partial shade Zone 4



JOE PYE WEED, BABY JOE

The perfect size for smaller gardens, this is a lovely midsized selection of Joe-Pye Weed. It forms a bushy upright mound of coarse dark-green leaves, bearing large umbrella-like heads of magenta-pink flowers in late summer. Suitable for planting in moist to wet areas. This plant grows to average height of 2.5' tall. Full sun to partial shade Zone 4-9



LIGULARIA, BRITT-MARIE

Forms a clump of large, rounded maroon-black leaves. Taller stems appear in midsummer, bearing clusters of bright golden orange daisy flowers. Grows to 4' tall and 3' wide. Part shade Zone 3-9



LOBELIA, BLUE

A clump-forming perennial which features light to dark blue, tubular flowers. Flowers arise from the upper leaf forming a dense stiff, unbranched, leafy stalks typically rising 2-3' tall. Finely-toothed, lanceshaped, light green leaves. Late summer bloom period. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-9



LUNGWORT, BER. ANDERSON Features large clusters of bright cobalt-blue flowers on the ends of arching stems. Foliage is long and narrow, dark green with silver spots. Grows to 10" tall and 23" wide. Part to full shade Zone 3-9



LUNGWORT, RASP. SPLASH

This selection features clusters of up facing deep raspberry-pink bells, the narrow green leaves are heavily spotted in silver. Plants should be cut back hard immediately after blooming, to rejuvenate the leaves, which will then remain attractive all season. Evergreen in mild winter regions. Grows to the height of 14" tall and 24" wide. Part to full shade Zone 3-9



LUNGWORT, ROY DAVIDSON

This clump-forming lungwort cultivar, and is more valued for its attractive foliage than its flowers. Grows typically to 12" high and spreads to 18-24" wide. Features mostly clumps of large, medium green leaves with large, silvery spotting. Drooping clusters of funnel-shaped flowers bloom in spring. Flowers open pink and mature to sky blue. Part to full shade Zone 3-9



LYDIA, GROUNDCOVER

This is a low growing shrub with an abundance of intensely yellow flowers that bloom late spring and summer. Its ability to cascade makes it a favorite for hillside and container plantings. It will otherwise grow to a nice mounded form and can provide a sunny patch of color as a groundcover or border. Drought tolerant and virtually carefree. Will grow to 18" tall and 3' wide at mature height. Full sun to partial shade Zone 6-9



PEONY, ALEX FLEMING

This peony is a shrubby plant that will typically grow to 3' tall by midspring, bloom, display attractive foliage throughout the summer and early fall, and then die to the ground after frost. An old standard that features very large, very fragrant, pink double flowers. Glossy green foliage is divided into oval to lance-shaped leaflets. Each plant will flower for approximately 7-10 days. Full sun Zone 3-8



PEONY, CHARLES WHITE

This is a prized peony. White crowned with double petals, lightly fragrant, and grows to 36" tall. Large outer petals surround globular incurved white bomb with a glow of yellow from inside. Tall enough to be at the back of a border garden. Full sun Zone 2-9



PEONY, CHINESE TREE

Tree peonies truly are the rare jewels of the peony world. Woody stemmed, shrub like plants will grow to their mature size in 5 to 8 years. Blossoms will reach 5"-6" wide. Plants range from 2 1/2' to 5' tall. Provide light shade from the hot mid-day sun and protection from drying winds. Zones 4-8



PEONY, DINNER PLATE

This peony has pink double blossoms, blooms in late midseason, approx. 33 - 43" tall, with a faint fragrance. Aptly named because the flowers are enormous — up to 7" in diameter; beautiful, rose-form lilac pink blossoms; soft, mild fragrance; tall plant, strong grower; lush, dark green foliage; long, strong stems. Full sun Zone 4-9



PEONY, DUCHESS DE

This peony cultivar is a shrubby plant that, each year, will typically grow to 3' tall by mid-spring, bloom, display attractive foliage throughout the summer and early fall, and then die to the ground after frost. An old standard that features large, very fragrant, double flowers (white bombs) with cupped, white guard petals and dense light yellow centers. Blooms in late mid-season. Full sun Zone 3-8



PEONY, FELIX

Very large and very fragrant large bomb-shaped brilliant ruby-red flowers bloom in spring above glossy green foliage. Grows 2 to 3' tall and wide. Great in mass plantings or as a specimen. Full sun Zone 4-9



PEONY, FELIX SUPREME

Lightly fragrant, double ruby-red flowers bloom in spring above glossy dark green foliage. Has a rounded growth habit and matures at 2 to 3 feet tall and wide. Excellent in mass plantings or as a specimen. Full sun Zone 4-9



PEONY, FESTIVA MAXIMA

Very large, white double flowers with a prominent crimson middle. Blooms in early spring on tall plants, 24-30" tall and wide. The flowers are fragrant and are excellent for cut flowers. Full sun Zone 4-9



PEONY, FLAME

Cupped, scarlet blossoms with very wide petals, and a center of golden stamens; in sandy soil, the color may be closer to a deep coral pink; vigorous, bush which grows quickly to a large clump with numerous flowers; abundant, glossy green foliage; strong stems — doesn't need staking; great garden plant and good cut flower. Approx. 26 - 32" tall. Full sun Zone 4-9



PEONY, JULES ELIE

Pink, bomb-type double, very fragrant, midseason, 36" tall, lactiflora cultivar. These fragrant blossoms are a lively light rose-pink. This heirloom classic is a good cut flower. May need support. Full sun Zone 4-9



PEONY, KANSAS

Huge, carmine-red double flowers bloom mid to late spring on very strong erect stems. A fast grower matures at 1.5 to 2 feet tall and 2 to 3 feet wide. Considered the best double red Peony. Excellent in the garden or as a cut flower. Full sun Zone 4-9



PEONY, KARL ROSENFIELD

Considered by many to be the best red double; produces lots of flowers of a loose semi-rose form; large, intense cherry red blooms, with notched petal tips; some golden stamens showing through; lush foliage; may need staking; good garden and cut flower variety. Approx. 30 - 36" tall Zone 4-9



PEONY, MISTER ED

Blushing pink, bomb-type double, lightly fragrant, midseason, 36" tall cultivar. May have pink flowers and luscious blush-cream blooms on the same bush. Good cut flower with a light fragrance. Full sun Zone 3-8



PEONY, PAULA FAY

Vibrant bright pink semi-double flower with yellow centers make choice cut flowers. Fast growing 2 1/2 to 3 ft. tall and wide. Full sun Zone 4 - 8



PEONY, RASP. SUNDAE

Luscious double pink flowers with cream tones have versatile color for high profile foundation beds and perennial borders. Robust plants produce plenty of lush foliage. Fast grower to 2 1/2 ft. tall and wide. Full sun Zone 4 - 8



PEONY, SCARLET O'HARA

Very tall, robust plant; large, vibrant scarlet red petals with contrasting center of golden stamens; petals fade to cerise pink in sunlight; rich deep green foliage; vigorous, easy to grow. Approx. 36 - 42" tall. Full sun Zone 4-9



PEONY, TREE ASSORTED

Tree peonies truly are the rare jewels of the peony world. Woody stemmed, shrub like plants will grow to their mature size in 5 to 8 years. Blossoms will reach 5"-6" wide. Plants range from 2 1/2' to 5' tall. Provide light shade from the hot mid-day sun and protection from drying winds. Zones 4-8



PHLOX, CREEPING

Creeping phlox is a vigorous, spreading, mat-forming, sun-loving phlox that grows to only 6" tall but spreads to 24" wide. It is noted for its creeping habit, it's linear to awl-shaped leaves (which retain some green in winter) and its profuse carpet of mid-spring flowers with notched flower petals. Full sun Zone 3-9



PINCUSHION FLOWER

Lacy, lavender-blue, and pincushion-like flowers 2 inches in diameter bloom on 12 to 15-inch tall stems from late spring to early fall. Graygreen foliage forms a mounded rosette that grows 6 to 8 inches tall and 12 to 15 inches wide. Blooms repeatedly through the season if regularly deadheaded. It excels in the border, rock gardens, and as a cut flower. Butterflies love it. Full sun Zone 4



PLUMBAGO

Plumbago is an evergreen shrub with whip-like semi-woody stems that form a loose, rounded mound 3-10 ft high with a similar spread. With long, thin stems and pale blue flowers, it's prized as a shrub, climber, potted plant and groundcover. Plumbago bloom-s all year long except for the coldest winter months. Full sun Zone 8-11



POKER PLANT, FLAMENCO

Plants form a big clump of grassy leaves that remain evergreen in milder regions. This mixture produces large bottlebrush heads in a range of shades, including yellow, orange and flame red. Drought tolerant. Reaches 18-24 in. tall and wide. Bloom spikes to 36 in. tall. Full sun Zone 5-9



POKER PLANT, PFITZER HYB

This perennial has arching foliage 2' long with erect flower stalks reaching 3' tall. Flowers start as a red bud and open to orange or deep yellow blooms. Flowers attract hummingbirds. Deer resistant. Partial shade to full sun. Zone 4



PRIMROSE, GLOW MAGENTA Fuzzy buds open to deep pink flowers that stand out against its deep green foliage. It has a plant height of 6" and a spread of 5-10", making an impressive low prostate spreading mound. Glowing Magenta is unusually compact for its species and has an extremely long flowering time, (June to September.) Full sun Zone 4-8



PRIMROSE, LEMON DROP

Lemon drop is a compact, erect, day-flowering member of the evening primrose family. It typically grows 8-12" tall and produces four-petaled lemon yellow flowers over a long summer bloom. Full sun Zone 5-9



RODGERSFLOWER, ELEGANS

Large airy plumes of soft-pink to ivory flowers appear in early to midsummer. Clumps seldom need dividing, but this may be done in early spring. The foliage often takes on a bronze caste when first emerging in the spring. Grows 3-4' tall. Part shade Zone 4-9



RUSSIAN SAGE

Shrubby, aromatic, gray-green Russian Sage with pale blue summer flowers. Makes a striking plant for the herbaceous border. Tolerates some drought and thrives in heat and full sun. Grows 2 to 3 feet tall and wide. Attracts butterflies. Full sun Zone 5



RUSSIAN SAGE, LITTLE

An improved selection of the species, this sun-loving perennial stalwart has a shorter upright habit that prevents it from leaning in the landscape. Mature height is 2 feet. Like its cousins, it is heat and drought tolerant. Small tubular lavender-blue flowers grace this woodytype perennial with its aromatic, finely dissected, gray-green foliage from summer to fall. Full sun Zone 4-9



SALVIA, MARCUS

A dwarf clump-forming perennial salvia with deep violet flowers that typically grows to only 8-10" tall. Erect, deep violet flower spikes appear in a lengthy summer bloom. Full sun Zone 4-8



SALVIA, MAY NIGHT

A clumping perennial producing dark, dense flower spikes in early summer amid gray-green leaves. Grows to 18 to 24 inches tall and wide. Deadhead for rebloom. Ideal for borders, beds or as cut flowers. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. Full sun Zone 4



SALVIA, NEW BLUE

They are compact plants that typically grow in erect but spreading clumps to 12" tall and to 18" wide. New Dimension Blue produces deep and intense violet-blue blooms that appear in dense, narrow, terminal spikes rising well above the foliage clump over a long May to August bloom period. Full sun Zone 5-8



SEDUM, ANGELINA

Brilliant needle-shaped golden yellow foliage with orange tips in autumn. Flowers are bright yellow and bloom in summer. A matforming vigorous grower reaches 3 to 6 inches high and 24 inches wide in a single year. Full sun Zone 3



SEDUM, AUTUMN CHARM

Autumn Charm has light green leaves with a buttery white band on the serrated edges of each leaf. Very stable and incredibly showy. White buds open to rosy pink, and then brick red tones develop in the flowerheads as fall arrives. It grows to the height of 18" tall. Good winter interest. Deer resistant. Full sun Zone 3



SEDUM, AUTUMN FIRE

Autumn Fire sedum is a cultivar that grows up to 2 feet tall and 18 inches wide with large showy pink blooms that eventually change to red. This drought tolerant plant blooms from late summer to early fall. Full sun Zone 3-9



SEDUM, AUTUMN JOY

A clump-forming perennial that features masses of tiny, star-like flowers which emerge pink, gradually change to deep rose-red and then coppery-rust in autumn as they die. Flowers appear in large, 3-6" across, flattened heads atop stems of grayish-green, fleshy, rounded, succulent-like leaves growing in upright to slightly spreading clumps, typically to 2' tall. Full sun Zone 3-9



SEDUM, BLUE SPRUCE

Steel blue .5-inch long needle-like foliage grows to 4 inches tall with a spread of 12 inches. Has yellow flowers in summer. A great groundcover and great for mixed containers. Heat and drought tolerant. Full sun Zone 3



SEDUM, GROUNDCOVER

Red leaves all year. Sedum Red Carpet does not flower, but the foliage is so colorful you won't notice. Foliage will turn a more vibrant mahoganyred with cooler fall temperatures. Low-maintenance plant great for rock gardens. Extremely drought tolerant. Average height is 4" tall. Full sun Zone 3-9



SEDUM, NEON

Neon typically grows in upright to slightly spreading clumps to 15-20" tall. Dense masses of tiny, star-like, bright neon pink flowers bloom in large, rounded, flattened heads atop stout stems clad with fleshy, rounded, succulent-like, light gray-green leaves. Long late summer to fall bloom period. Full sun Zone 3-9



SPIDERWORT, BLUE & GOLD

Blue and Gold is a compact, clump-forming, hybrid spiderwort that is noted for its unique yellow foliage. It typically grows to 12" tall. Threepetaled, purplish-blue flowers accented by contrasting yellow stems. Numerous flower buds form in each cluster, but individual flowers open up only a few at a time, each for only one day, blooming in succession from May into summer. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-9



SPIDERWORT, CONC. GRAPE

This spiderwort hybrid is a compact, clump-forming perennial which typically grows to 12" tall. Purplish-blue, three-petaled flowers accented by contrasting yellow stems. Numerous flower buds form in each cluster, but individual flowers open up only a few at a time, each for only one day, blooming in succession from May into August. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-7



SPIDERWORT, SWEET KATE

Sweet Kate is a compact, clump-forming, hybrid spiderwort that is noted for its unique yellow foliage. It typically grows to 12" tall. Threepetaled, purplish-blue flowers accented by contrasting yellow stems. Numerous flower buds form in each cluster, but individual flowers open up only a few at a time, each for only one day, blooming in succession from May into summer. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-9



SPIDERWORT, ZWAN BLUE

This selection has large flowers in a rich violet-blue shade. Plants should be trimmed back hard after the first flush of flowers is over, to rejuvenate the foliage and encourage repeat bloom in late summer. Happiest in a sunny, moist site. Divide clumps every 2 to 3 years in spring. Flowers are attractive to butterflies. Grows up to 2'tall and wide. Full sun Zone 4-9



ST. JOHNSWORT, GR. COVER

This groundcover typically grows 12" high and 24" wide, which is frequently planted as a ground cover. Features large, rose-like, 5petaled, yellow flowers. Flowers appear singly or in groups of 2-3 and cover the plant in summer. Oval to oblong, distinctively net-veined leaves are rich green in sun but are a lighter, yellowish green in shade. Full sun Zone 5-9



STOKES ASTER, HONEY SONG

Has a leathery, strap-like leaves that form a clump at the base with huge true royal purple daisy-like flowers with a hint of red at the end of the stem. The purple flowers bloom from July until frost and have a plant height of 14" and a plant spread of 18-24". Full sun Zone 5-9



STOKES ASTER, P. PARASOL

Purple Parasols features fluffy, cornflower-like flowers on generally erect, leafy stems growing to 18" tall. The flower color as initially light blue, becoming darker blue, then bluish purple to reddish purple and finally dark hot pink. Rosettes are evergreen in warm winter climates. Long summer to early autumn bloom. Full sun Zone 5-9



STOKES ASTER, MEL'S BLUE

An upright selection with 4" wide periwinkle blue blooms held high and flat on strong stems. Bloom time from late June to August that flowers continuously. Growth is 12-15" tall by 10-12" wide. Full sun Zone 5-10



STOKESIA, COLOR WHEEL

This compact selection produces large, shaggy flowers that open white and then age to deep mauve purple, for a multicolor effect. It forms a low mound of leathery green leaves, remaining evergreen in mild winter areas. Grows up to 12" high. Full sun Zone 5-9



SWEET FLAG

Brilliant butter-yellow variegated foliage. Good for accent, mass plantings, water's edge, or shallow ponds. Excellent choice to brighten up a dark moist area of the garden. Reaches 10 inches tall and 10 to 12 inches wide. Full sun to part shade Zone 7



THREADLEAF BLUESTAR

An erect, clump-forming plant that is primarily grown in cultivation for its blue spring flowers, feathery green summer foliage and golden fall color. Powdery blue, 1/2" star-like flowers appear in terminal clusters in late spring atop stems rising to 3' tall. Feathery, soft-textured, needlelike, alternate leaves are bright green in spring and summer, but turn bright gold in autumn. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-8



TOAD LILY, BLUE WONDER

Blue Wonder is a compact hybrid cultivar that typically grows in a vaseshaped clump to 18-24" tall on upright stems with medium to dark green leaves. Small, creamy white/powder blue, lily-like flowers with heavy blue-purple spotting/blotching and purple anthers appear in clusters in the upper leaf axils and stem tips in a late summer to fall bloom. Part shade to full shade Zone 5-8



TOAD LILY, GILT EDGE

Gilt Edge is a compact form with variegated foliage that typically grows in a clump to 12-24" tall, but will spread over time to 36" wide. Stemclasping leaves have irregular creamy white to chartreuse margins. Leaves generally remain attractive throughout the growing season. Part shade to full shade Zone 5-8



TOAD LILY, HIRTA HYBRID

Leafy, arching stems produce a fall display of bizarre star-shaped flowers. This species features white to pale lilac flowers, spotted with dark purple, over green foliage. Can grow up to 2-3'. Shade Zone 4-9



TURTLEHEAD, HOTLIPS

Hot lips is an upright, clump-forming perennial which typically grows 2-4' tall on stiff, square stems. Hooded , snapdragon-like, two-lipped, pink flowers bloom in tight, spike-like terminal racemes from late summer into fall (late July to September). Flowers have puffy pink corollas with lower lips bearded with yellow hairs. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-8



VERONICA, ROYAL CANDLES

Breathtaking blooms and a clean habit make this improved Veronica selection a landscape must. Unlike other types, Royal Candles has deep green foliage that does not die out and summer long profusion of candle-like tapers of violet-blue flowers. Mature plant height is 15-18 inches. Full sun Zone 4



VIRGINA BLUEBELLS

One inch long pink flower buds turn blue as they open resembling clusters of bluebells. Grows to 12-24 inches tall. Shade Zone 2



WISTERIA, LAWRENCE

Lawrence Wisteria is covered in stunning chains of fragrant sky blue pea-like flowers with a white flare dangling from the stems from early to mid-spring. It has green foliage which emerges coppery-bronze in spring. The narrow pinnately compound leaves turn yellow in fall. Can grow to 30' tall with a 2' spread. Full sun Zone 6
