ENGLISH LAUREL, OTTO

'Otto Luyken' is a compact cultivar that **grows only 3-4 feet tall and spreads to 6-8 feet.** Over time it can grow 6-10 feet tall. It is free-flowering. Best grown in moist, organically rich, well-drained soils. Tolerates shade. Good soil drainage is essential. Plants generally prefer sun in the cooler areas of the growing range and shadier conditions in the hotter areas of the growing range. Full sun to part shade Zone 6-8



ENGLISH LAUREL, SKIP

Skip Laurel is a dense growing evergreen shrub with lustrous evergreen foliage and clusters of small white flowers in the spring. It is rated as one of the cold hardiest of cherry laurels. Skip laurel **grows 10 to 12 feet tall.** Good soil drainage and proper air movement are crucial to avoid outbreaks of potentially serious disease and pest problems. Full sun to part shade Zone 6-8



EUONYMUS, EAST. WAHOO

Eastern wahoo is a deciduous, Missouri native shrub which is most often grown for its attractive red berries and fall color. Typically appears as an upright, spreading shrub with an irregular crown growing to **10-15' tall.** Dark green elliptic to ovate leaves turn dull red to greenish red in fall. Scarlet red fruits appear in autumn. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-9



EUONYMUS, MANHATTAN

is a medium sized, upright growing evergreen shrub to **6 feet tall** with glossy dark green leaves. Its greenish white flowers are followed by rounded pinkish fruits. The flowers are showy and fragrant! Full sun to part shade Zone 5




FORSYTHIA, GOLD TIDE

Gold Tide is a dwarf forsythia cultivar that is noted for its compact-spreading shape, **typically growing to only 20" tall but spreading to as much as 4' wide.** It features light yellow flowers that appear in profusion before the leaves emerge in late winter to early spring. Early bloom makes this shrub a true harbinger of spring. Full sun to part shade Zone 5-8



FORSYTHIA, SHOW OFF

This unique shrub covers itself in earliest spring with bright yellow blooms that adorn the stems all the way from the ground to the very tips! Its dark green foliage keeps it attractive all season long, and it never needs pruning, keeping its neat and tidy shape year after year.





FORSYTHIA, SPRING GLORY

Showy, rounded shrub that explodes in brilliant masses of yellow flowers. Use as a background shrub or as an accent in the perennial garden. Upright grower, excellent as a screen. Deciduous. Grows to the **height of 5-10' tall with a 4-7' spread**. Full sun Zone 3



FOTHERGILLA, DWARF

It is a compact, slow-growing, mounded, deciduous shrub that typically **grows 2-3' tall and as wide.** Flowers in dense terminal bottlebrush-like spikes bloom in spring. Leaves turn often brilliant shades of yellow, orange and red in fall. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



FORTHERGILLA, MT. AIRY

This is a vigorous deciduous shrub that **grows 4-5' tall** and is noted for its profuse spring flowering, excellent summer foliage, excellent fall color and consistently upright habit. Terminal, bottlebrush-like spikes of tiny, honey like fragrance, white flowers bloom in spring after the foliage emerges. Foliage turns excellent shades of yellow, orange and red-purple in fall. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



HYBISCUS, LIL' KIM

Growing to only 3-4' tall and wide, this unique little shrub creates many new landscape opportunities like mixed container and perennial beds. The 3" pure white flowers are punctuated with a showy red eye and last for three days instead of one day like other Rose of Sharon. Full sun Zone 5-8



HYPERICUM, COBALT N GOLD This mounded grower has silver-green foliage blanketed with ¾"sunny yellow flowers that are irresistible to butterflies in the late spring and early summer. This hardy specimen attains a height of 2-3 feet tall and **4-5 feet wide.** The leaves transforms themselves into yellow, orange and red in the fall. Full sun and well-drained soil. Full sun Zone 4-7



HYPERICUM, GOLDEN RULE

An excellent ground covering subshrub for shade, Golden Rule has colorful orange new growth and attractive yellow foliage. Yellow summer flowers up to 2" across add to its appeal. Grows 12" tall and wide. Although it is not as aggressive as the green-leafed varieties, it will benefit from a trimming one or two times per year. Sun to part sun Zone 5



ITEA, HENRYS GARNET

A compact, rounded shrub with arching branches that **grows 3 to 5 feet tall and 4 to 6 feet wide.** Large white fragrant flowers are produced in early summer. Long lasting fall color is a brilliant dark maroon with hints of pink and red. Full to part sun Zone 5



ITEA, LITTLE HENRY

Sweetly scented, pure white flowers on a low mounded, compact bush. Arching branches are loaded with blooms in early summer. Produces brilliant fall colors. **Grows 1.5 to 2 feet tall and 3 feet wide**. Full to part sun Zone 5



ITEA, MERLOT

This is a very nice dwarf bush of the native Virginia sweetspire. It is very dense and compact, **growing to around 3 feet tall and wide.** The flower clusters arch and spray above the foliage beautifully. Fall foliage turns deep red. Grow Merlot in moist to average soil. Plant in flower or in fall color is a dazzler, and also a butterfly magnet. Sun to part shade Zone 5-9



JUNIPER, CALGARY CARPET

Spreading branches with flaring sprays of feathery soft green foliage form a juniper with a nest like appearance. Great foundation plant, or for mass plantings. Grows to **the height of 12-24" Tall with a 3-4' spread.** Full sun to part shade Zone 3



JUNIPER, BLUE RUG

A spectacular very low trailing Juniper, with definite silver-blue color. Good growth habit with a full center. Excellent for a ground cover or bank planting. **Grows to a height of 6-8 inches and spread to 6-8 feet.** Full sun Zone 3



JUNIPER, DAUBS FROSTED

Soft textured, blue-green foliage is accented by golden new growth. Great for erosion control along banks and slopes. Full sun, well-drained soil drought resistant once established. **Grows 2-3 feet tall and 6 feet wide**. Full sun Zone 4-9



JUNIPER, GREY GUARDIAN

This beautiful greyish-blue low spreading Juniper, a sport from Grey Owl, has a tighter growth habit and more vivid color. It is perfect as a foundation plant growing **2 to 3 feet tall and 3 to 5 feet wide**. Full sun Zone 4



JUNIPER, GREY OWL

A low, spreading Juniper that **grows 2-3 feet tall and 4-6 feet wide.** The finely-textured foliage is an attractive silver-blue. The outer branches are thread-like and open, becoming denser toward the center. Full sun Zone 4



JUNIPER, HUGHES

This silvery-blue, low growing, spreading juniper is a `very popular where it is known. The **Hughes grows to a height of 15 inches tall with a 6-8 foot spread**. Adds great color to any landscape. Full sun Zone 3-8



JUNIPER, SAYBROOK GOLD

By far the brightest gold juniper, "superior" to all gold tip types on the market. The bright color is maintained through all seasons. **Grows 2-3 feet tall and 6 feet wide**. The low compact profile is ideal for foundation or mass plantings. Full sun Zone 4



JUNIPER, SKANDIA

A low-growing, semi-spreading evergreen matures at **14-18** inches high and 6 feet wide. The pale, grayish-green, feathery foliage holds its color over the winter. Good for foundation or mass border plant. Blight resistant. Full sun Zone 3



JUNIPER, SEA GREEN

Fine-textured, bright green foliage is displayed on gracefully arching branches. This fountain or semi-vased, compact evergreen **grows 4-6 feet tall and 6-8 feet wide at maturity.** Full sun Zone 4



LILAC. BLOOMERANG

In the spring, the Bloomerang is like any other lilac bush, or at least like any other dwarf lilac bush. It blooms in May, like most lilacs tend to do, and after two or three weeks the blooms die back. Come July however, the plant will provide another set of blossoms, and often will continue to bloom until the first frost. **Grows 4-5' tall and wide**. Full sun Zone 3



LILAC, COMMON PURPLE

This old fashioned lilac is the one most of us remember from our youth. A perfect informal hedge or screen, it has extremely fragrant, purple flowers in May. Color may vary from purple to lilac and occasionally even white. **Grows to 12-15 feet tall and 8-12 feet wide.** Full to part sun Zone 2-7



LILAC, COMMON WHITE

This hardy vigorous shrub is the white version of the old fashioned favorite. It has attractive foliage, single white flowers, and makes a great informal hedge or screen. **Grows to 12-15 feet tall and 8-12 feet wide**. Full to part sun Zone 2-7



LILAC, DWARF KOREAN

This dwarf variety has an excellent uniform habit and red-purple buds that open to fragrant, single pale lilac flowers. **Grows 4-5 feet tall and 5-7 feet wide.** Full sun Zone 3-7



LILAC, MINUET

Its large dark green leaves fully clothe branches, as light purple flower buds open to single, soft white-pink blooms. **Grows to 6-8 feet tall and 4-6 feet wide.** Full sun Zone 2-7



LILAC, MISS KIM

This hardy lilac from Korea has purple buds that open to single, fragrant, pale lilac flowers when other lilacs have finished. It grows 6-7 feet tall and 5-6 feet wide with a broad, spreading shape. Full sun Zone 3-7



LILAC, SENSATION

This hybrid lilac has single, fragrant, deep purple flowers that are bordered with a distinctive white edge. This upright rounded shrub blooms in May and provides unique cut flowers. This type of lilac can reach up to 10' tall with a 12' spread. Full sun Zone 3



LILAC, SWEET TREAT

Has exceptional tolerance to summer heat scorch. It's a compact shrub **growing to 3 feet tall and wide.** The spring flowers are very sweetly fragrant and the dark green leaves turn burgundy in autumn. A low maintenance plant that also has an excellent resistance to powdery mildew. Full sun Zone 3



LYDIA, DYERS GREENWEED

Low mounding shrub with very showy early summer pea-like flowers. Bright yellow blooms followed by dark green foliage. Makes a great groundcover and is easily planted on slopes for erosion control. **Grows up to 2 feet tall and 3 feet wide.** Full sun Zone 4



NANDINA, GULF STREAM

Forms a large compact mound with good red winter foliage and vigorous growth. With nice metallic blue-green summer foliage, it **grows 3 to 3.5 feet tall and slightly less in the spread.** Extremely dense in habit and foliage with inflorescence about 4 inches long. Full to part sun Zone 6



NANDINA, MOYERS RED

Reaching up to **approximately 6 feet tall,** 'Moyer's Red bears pink to white flowers in spring with small star-shaped, white flowers with large, yellow anthers. Fine purple-red foliage adds superior fall color. The red berry-like clusters are persistent through winter. This is an upright ever green shrub. Sun to part shade Zone 6



NINEBARK, AMBER JUBILEE

Rounded and dense in habit, this shrub with its bold colors of orange, yellow and gold, will stand out in your garden. Delicate white bloom are produced in spring, and fall foliage is highlighted with tones of red and purple, making this ninebark appealing over the entire season. Grows to the **height of 6-8 feet tall and 5-6 feet wide.** Full to part sun Zone 2-7



NINEBARK, CENTER GLOW

This Ninebark's new foliage is a lovely red color with a bright yellow base. Light pink buds open to clusters of white flowers. Bush will mature at **8 to 10 feet tall with a 6 to 8 foot spread** and the foliage will have a deep wine color. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



NINEBARK, LITTLE DEVIL

This Ninebark features deep burgundy foliage throughout the season and small white-pink clusters of flowers in June. **Growing only to 4 feet,** it makes a great background or shrub border. It is also disease and pest resistant and requires very little maintenance. It keeps its great compact shape without pruning. Full sun Zone 3



NINEBARK, SUMMER WINE

Neat compact branching and fine, deeply cut, dark crimson-red leaves. This native variety has pinkish-white, button-like flowers in midsummer. It is very showy and is extremely hardy. Used as a landscape shrub, **maturing at 5 to 6 feet tall and wide**. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



PINE, MUGO

This is a dwarf, low-growing, spreading pine. Nice dark evergreen, stiff needles that are 2 - 3 inches long. **Grows 4' tall and 5' wide**. Very tolerant - can handle poor, rocky, dry, windy conditions. Widely used in foundation plantings, and is an excellent choice for bonsai projects and Japanese gardens. Full to part sun Zone 3



PLUM YEW, DUKE

A graceful shrub with a spreading, mounded habit. This selection has a very fine texture, with dense, glossy, needle-like foliage that maintains color year-round. Good for small gardens, low hedges or borders. Deer resistant. Evergreen. **Slow grower to 4 to 6 ft. tall and wide.** Full to part sun Zone 6



PRIVET, SUNSHINE

Perfect for a low, exceptionally colorful, formal hedge that can be maintained as low as 1 foot in height, bright golden-yellow foliage. **Grows to 3-4' tall and wide.** Full sun Zone 6
