

HOLLY

BERRY POPPINS

(LATIN: ILEX VERICILLATA) 4' T & 4' W Tiny white flowers mature to clusters of show stopping red berries. Sumptuous berry clusters remain after leaves fall often lasting until early spring. Plant one male Mr. Poppins for every ten female Berry Poppins. Part sun Zone 3-9



BERRY HEAVY

(LATIN: ILEX VERICILLATA) 8' T & 10' W Brighten up the winter landscape with Berry Heavy®! Produces copious amounts of bright orange-red berries to be enjoyed in the fall through winter. It will often lose its leaves earlier than other cultivars making for a spectacular fruit display in autumn. Requires a male plant to create berries such as 'Jim Dandy' Winterberry. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



BLUE GIRL

(LATIN: ILEX MESERVEAE) 8' T & 6' W, moderate grower, needs weekly watering or more in extreme heat, female, needs blue boy to pollinate to get red berries. Evergreen. Full to part sun Zone 5



BLUE COMBO

(LATIN: ILEX MESERVEAE) Brilliantly combined in one container (blue prince and blue princess) eliminates the need for two separate plants for pollination. Full to part sun Zone 5



BLUE MAID

(LATIN: ILEX MESERVEAE) 10' T & 8' W An exceptionally hardy, vigorous, broadleaf evergreen with snag-free, purplish-green holly foliage that is well suited along walkways or border plantings. A true holly look in a dense, bushy plant with bright red berries and purple stems. Evergreen. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



BLUE PRINCE

(LATIN: ILEX MESERVEAE) 10-12' T & 8' W Features one of the most attractive Holly foliage. Blue Prince forms a natural pyramid. White flowers bloom continuously all summer providing multiple berry sets for Blue Angel and Blue Princess. Excellent as a hedge. Part sun Zone 5



BLUE PRINCESS

(LATIN: ILEX MESERVEAE) 10' T & 8' W, moderate grower, needs watered in extreme heat, female, needs blue prince to pollinate to get bright red berries. Evergreen. Full sun to part shade Zone 5



BLUE STALLION

(LATIN: ILEX MESERVEAE) 10' T & 8' W, upright pyramidal, male, needs regular watering, protect from winter sun and wind, evergreen. Sun to part shade Zone 5-9



CASTLE SPIRE

(LATIN: ILEX MESERVEAE) 12' T & 4' W, compact narrow pyramidal, fast grower, loves damp soil, needs castle wall to pollinate for red berries. Evergreen. Sun to part sun Zone 5



CASTLE WALL

(LATIN: ILEX MESERVEAE) 8' T & 4' W, luscious green, compact pyramidal, fast grower, one plant will pollinate multiple females. Great for hedges. Evergreen. Sun to part sun Zone 5



CENTENIAL GIRL

(LATIN: ILEX CENTENIAL GIRL) 12' T & 6' W, broad upright pyramidal, slow grower, blue stallion or blue prince is a good pollinator, evergreen. Part shade Zone 4-9



CHINA BOY

(LATIN: ILEX MESDOB) 10' T & 8' W, dense branches for a great hedge, fast grower, pollinates china girl holly, needs watered in extreme heat, evergreen. Full sun to part shade Zone 4



CHINA GIRL

(LATIN: ILEX MESOG) 10' T & 8' W, dense branches for a great hedge, fast grower, water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use china boy to pollinate to get red berries. Full sun to part shade Zone 4



FALSE GOSHIKI

(LATIN: ILEX OSMANTHUS) 5' T & 4' W within 10 years. May reach 10' T with age. New leaves are red then turn green. Variegated leaf. Regular watering, evergreen. Full sun to part shade Zone 6-9



FOSTER

(LATIN: ILEX ATTEUATTA) 25' T & 12' W, pyramidal, fast grower, drought tolerant, evergreen. Full sun Zone 6-9



HELEN

(LATIN: ILEX OPACA) A female selection has fragrant flowers and medium, dark green foliage. Grows to the **height of 20-30 feet tall and 20 feet wide**. White flowers in the spring and dark red fruit in the winter. Full sun to shade Zone 5-9



JIM DANDY

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) 6' T & 5' W, upright, slow grower, dwarf, deciduous. Pollinate with red sprite holly. Fall color: yellow to purple, bronze. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-9



JOHNNY LATELY

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) 10' T, Johnny Come Lately winterberry is a late blooming male clone like Southern Gentleman which is appropriate for pairing with female late-bloomers like Winter Red. Deciduous. Full sun to part shade Zone 4-9



LITTLE GOBLIN GUY

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) Little Goblin Guy winterberry holly is a male pollinator for Little Goblin Orange and Little Goblin Red. Though it will not bear fruit itself, it plays a crucial role in getting the best from the female varieties. Little Goblin Guy blooms at the same time as the female Little Goblin varieties, guaranteeing a good crop of showy berries all winter long. **Grows 3-4 ft. tall and wide.** Sun to part sun
Zone 3



LITTLE GOBLIN ORANGE

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) Little Goblin Orange winterberry holly lights up the darkest season with dozens of extra-large, bright orange berries. **Little Goblin Orange is just 3-4' tall and wide.** In order to get fruit, you will need to plant Little Goblin Guy winterberry holly as a pollinator, one will pollinate 5-7 Little Goblin Orange and/or Little Goblin Red plants. Plant the male within 50' of the female varieties to ensure a heavy berry set. Sun to part sun Zone 3



LITTLE GOBLIN RED

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) This exciting new winterberry promises extra big and abundant rich-red berries on a dwarf plant. **Reaches 3-5 ft. tall and wide.** Its compact size makes it ideal for residential landscapes. Plant a Little Goblin Guy winterberry nearby to ensure berry production. Sun to part sun Zone 3



MARYLAND BEUT.

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) 7' T&W Maryland Beauty is a female cultivar which needs a male pollinator to produce the attractive red berries which are the signature of the winterberries. Male pollinator must be a shrub whose flowers bloom at the same time (Jim Dandy is recommended). One male winterberry will be sufficient for pollinating 6-10 female shrubs. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



MR POPPINS

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) 4' T& 4' W, Mr. Poppins is the male pollinator, a dwarf variety, necessary for berry production on Berry Poppins. Mr. Poppins and Berry Poppins will make a perfect couple. Tiny white flowers appear in spring on lush foliage, but no berries will develop on this Winterberry. A ratio of one male to ten females is sufficient. Bees do the transporting, so even a distance of 50-75' will work. Sun Zone 3-9



RED SPRITE

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) 3' T & 4' W, dense compact, moderate grower, deciduous, needs Jim Dandy to pollinate red berries. Fall color: yellow, green to purple bronze. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



SANTAS DELIGHT

Deep blue-green leaves are bordered by a wide creamy-white border which changes to pink in fall. Bright red berries complement the foliage and persist well into winter. A pyramidal shrub **10 to 12 ft. tall and 6 to 8 ft. wide**. A male English Holly pollinizer will provide best berry set. A proven winter survivor where similar varieties have failed. Evergreen. Full to part shade Zone 6



SATYR HILL

(LATIN: ILEX OPACA) 30' T & 20'W, Vigorous pyramidal form with spiny, olive green foliage and large red fruit. Sun to part sun Zone 4



SCARLET O' HARA

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) 8' T & W, upright spreading, deciduous, Jim Dandy will work on pollinating this shrub. Full to part sun Zone 4-9



SOUTH. GENTLEMEN

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) 10' T & W, upright rounded, slow grower, loves moist soil, deciduous. Male, very hardy. Full sun to part shade
Zone 4-9



WINTER RED

(LATIN: ILEX VERTICILLATA) 8' T & W, upright rounded, slow grower, deciduous, abundant red berries, Jim Dandy will work on pollinating this shrub. Full sun to part shade Zone 3-9
