ROSES

(LATIN: ROSA RUGOSA) A dense, upright, rounded shrub which typically grows 4-6' tall and 3-5' wide. Features fragrant, pure white, single flowers (to 3.5" across). Blooms profusely from late spring to late summer. Glossy, leathery, dark green foliage turns attractive shades of yellow, orange and red in fall. Full sun to part shade Zone 3



ALL ABLAZE

(LATIN: ROSA X 'WEKSAMSOU) Large clusters of sensational cherry red, ruffled, double flowers that will engulf a trellis or wall. Vigorous climbing canes **quickly reach 8 to 12 ft. long.** A hardy and vigorous climber that provides a continuous supply of showy blooms with a mildly spicy fragrance. Perfect for an arbor, fence, gateway, or pillar in any style garden. Blooms on old and new wood. Full sun Zone 5



ALL DRESSED UP

(LATIN: ROSA GLANDIFLORA) The appearance of an old-fashioned variety but possesses something most grandifloras don't have-excellent resistance to the diseases that can plague roses. You can count on large, full-bodied, soft pink flowers to emerge throughout the growing season. All Dressed Up reaches a height of up to 5' tall with a 4' spread. The high-centered flowers have the fragrance of freshly cut apples and draw pollinators to the landscape. Full sun to part shade Zone 4



ALBA

AT LAST

(LATIN: ROSA FLORIBUNDA) A robust, disease-resistant addition to the garden, this carefree, reblooming rose bush, produces clusters of lovely, fragrant flowers over a long season. Each cupped, double bloom is crowded with petals the color of honeyed apricot with hints of yellow at the center. The petals fade over time to a soft yellow with an apricot blush. A vigorous, bushy plant that **grow up to 3' tall.** Full sun Zone 5



AUTUMN SUNSET

(LATIN: ROSA) Autumn Sunset will light up your garden like the evening sky with rich hues of apricot and gold. Features rich fragrance, great hardiness and strong disease resistance (especially black spot). Combined with great shiny green foliage and a free-flowering habit that blooms on new and old wood. **Can grow to 12' tall with a 4' spread**. Full sun Zone 4



BLAZE IMPROVED

(LATIN: ROSA SP. BLAZE) produce a large abundance of scarlet red flowers. The round buds open to slighted cupped large double blooms, showing bright yellow stamens as the flowers fully open. Tall Blaze Improved will grow to be 12' - 15' in height. This rose blooms all summer long and is winter hardy. Full sun Zone 3



CALYPSO

(LATIN: ROSA BALYPSO) Numerous delightful apricot blooms cover this compact mounded shrub rose. Dark glossy green foliage. Recurrent double blooms promise color throughout the season. An ideal accent for the garden or foundation planting. Grows to 2' tall. Full sun Zone 5



CHRYSLER IMPERIAL TEA

(LATIN: ROSA 'CHRYSLER IMPERIAL') This timeless classic is a perfect example of what a hybrid tea should be high centered, velvety, strongly scented and with a great repeat. The large, shapely, dark red blooms are held on long stems clothed with dark green leaves. While happiest in hot temperatures, it doesn't disappoint wherever it calls home. 45 to 50 petals. **4-6 feet tall.** Full sun Zone 6



CINCO DE MAYO

(LATIN: ROSA HYBRID FLORIBUNDA) The flowers, which hold well and are fast to repeat, are a blend of smoked lavender & rusty redorange and sit amongst clean, glossy green foliage and dark red new growth. **Moderate growing; reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall and wide**. Its clean, round habit is ideal for use as a hedge or in a border with mixed perennials. Full to part sun Zone 5



PEACE TEA

(LATIN: ROSA PEACE) Pure pink flowers with lemony yellow edges bloom in the summer time. Bushy growth habit, growing 4 to 6 feet tall and 2 to 3 feet wide. Great for beds and landscapes. Full sun Zone 5



DOUBLE DELIGHT

(LATIN: ROSA HYBRID FLORIBUNDA) Beautiful double blooms with an eye-catching color combination and fantastic fragrance. **Grows 3-5' tall and wide**. The large, somewhat informal, old-fashioned, 24-30 petals are of rich, creamy white edged strawberry red. Full sun Zone 5



DOUBLE KNOCKOUT

(LATIN: ROSA 'DOUBLE KNOCKOUT') Knock Out is a compact, tidy shrub rose and resistant to black-spot. Blooms are fire engine red in cool weather and a cherry red in the summer months. The foliage is a dark purplish green and turns to burgundy in the fall. Tough foliage and blooms. Knock Out is drought tolerant and If left un-pruned, and they can easily grow to be more than **3-4' wide x 3-4' tall.** Full sun Zone 5



DRIFT APRICOT

(LATIN: ROSA HYBRIDA DRIFT) A true groundcover rose with bright double apricot flower blooms. They are extremely prolific bloomers of soft peach colored flowers from early spring right on thru till hard frost. Can **grow to 2' tall and 3' wide**. Full sun Zone 4



DRIFT CORAL

(LATIN: ROSA HYBRIDA DRIFT) Repeat-bloomers that are tough, disease resistant, winter hardy and virtually maintenance-free. Drift Roses are a cross between full-size groundcover roses and miniature roses. From the former they kept toughness, disease resistance and winter hardiness. Grows to the height of 3-5' tall with a 3-4' spread. Easy to grow and maintain, Easy Spirit features clean, glossy green foliage and strong disease resistance in an upright bush. Full sun Zone 5



GRAND CHAMP. RED

(LATIN: ROSA MEIMACOTA) This compact grower dons 3-inch double red flowers that bloom in late spring through summer. **Reaches 4 feet tall and wide.** Excellent disease resistance and is perfect for borders and beds. Drought tolerant. Full sun Zone 5



GRAND CHAMP. YLW

(LATIN: ROSA RADGARDEBYEL) This compact grower dons 2.5-inch yellow flowers that fade to white, bloom in late spring through summer. **Reaches 4 feet tall and wide.** Excellent disease resistance and is perfect for borders and beds. Full sun Zone 5



GRANDMAS BLESSING

(LATIN: ROSA BAling) This beauty is so sweet it was named after Margaret 'Grandma' Bailey. Clear, beautifully full, 3-4" dusty-pink flowers, bloom recurrently throughout the season. **Grows 2-3' tall and wide**. Its symmetrical, vase-shaped form and dark-green, diseaseresistant foliage along with the stunning color of the blooms. Full sun Zone 5



HANSA

(LATIN: ROSA RUGOSA) The Hansa rose is a semi-double crimson flower turning to a purplish-red with age. The flowers come in clusters, bloom heavily in June and lighter throughout the summer. It has dark green foliage, which turns orange in fall with red rose hips. **This plant gets to about 4-5' tall x 3-4' wide.** Has a light fragrance to it. Full sun Zone 3



HEAD OVER HEELS

(LATIN: ROSA BAleels) Full, fluffy, light pink flowers bloom repeatedly through the summer. **Grows 3' tall and wide**. This upright rose, with dark, glossy-green foliage would make an excellent plant for the middle of your garden border. Full sun Zone 5



JULIA CHILD

(LATIN: ROSA FLORIBUNDA) produces full buttery yellow blooms from June through September. **Grows up to 3 ft. tall and wide** Its prolific blooming and pleasant licorice-clove fragrance make this plant a must have in gardens and containers! Full sun Zone 4



KASHMIR

(LATIN: ROSA BAImir) Resembling a hybrid tea rose, the velvety red blossoms are as soft as cashmere and beg to be cut for the vase. **Grows 3' tall with a 4' spread.** With an evenly rounded habit, Kashmir fits perfectly into today's urban landscapes. Try this bold accent plant in the border, foundation or as a low hedge, hugging paths and walkways. Full sun Zone 4



KNOCKOUT RED

(LATIN: ROSA 'RADRAZZ') Knock Out is a compact, tidy shrub rose and resistant to black-spot. Blooms are fire engine red in cool weather and a cherry red in the summer months. The foliage is a dark purplish green and turns to burgundy in the fall. Tough foliage and blooms. Knock Out is drought tolerant and If left un-pruned, and they can easily grow to be more than **3-4' wide x 3-4' tall.** Petal count 5-11. Full sun Zone 5-9



KNOCKOUT SUNNY

(LATIN: ROSA SUNNY KNOCKOUT) Fragrant, bright yellow flowers mature to a cream color and are produced continuously and profusely. Extraordinary resistance to common rust, mildew and black spot foliage diseases. Makes a superb low hedge. Deciduous. **Grows 3-4 feet tall**. Full sun Zone 4-9



LIFE OF THE PARTY

(LATIN: ROSA FLORIBUNDA) Liven up your garden and delight your senses with this English-style shrub rose. Its bright yellow blooms entertain the eye and age with a blush of pink color. The blossoms exude a fruity fragrance to enjoy. With its rounded, compact and upright form, it brings small spaces and containers to life. Grows to the height of 3-4' tall with a 2-3' spread. This entertainer thrives in hot, dry climates and has good disease resistance. Full sun Zone 5



LIVIN' EASY

(LATIN: ROSA FLORIBUNDA) All you have to do is just stick it in the ground, give it a little water, kick back and watch it grow. The foliage is so glossy green and free from black spot that the bush looks great even without flowers. But you won't have much of an opportunity to see just leaves 'cause it blooms up a storm. Grows to the height of 3-4' tall with a 2-3' spread. Scrumptious flowers of showy apricot orange will light up your landscape. Full sun Zone 5



MANGO VERANDA

(LATIN: ROSA FLORIBUNDA) Mango Veranda blooms in shades of warm orange. The medium sized, old-fashioned flowers have a peachy reverse and turn more delicate in color with age. This healthy **2' - 3' rose plant** has a bushy habit and is decorated with glossy dark green foliage. Full sun Zone 5



NEW ZEALAND

(LATIN: ROSA HYBRID TEA) Wonderfully fragrant and floriferous, New Zealand is a lovely Hybrid Tea rose with very large, 6 in. across full, highcentered, shell pink flowers. Their reflexed and ruffled petals are adorned with delicate salmon-pink undertones that smell richly of honeysuckle. Blooms spring to fall. Grows to the height of 3-5' tall with a 2-3' spread. Full sun Zone 6



PAINT THE TOWN

(LATIN: ROSA BAItown) Wonderful clusters of red hybrid tea-shaped blooms carpet this rose from head to foot, to paint your town red. **Grows 3' tall with a 4' spread.** Glossy, dark green foliage accents the red perfectly and highlights the incredible flower effect all season long. The even spreading-to-mounded habit is as well-suited to container gardening as it is to the border. Highly disease-resistant. Full sun Zone 4



ROSIE THE RIVETER

(LATIN: ROSA FLORIBUNDA) Rosie the Riveter pays tribute to the women who worked in factories and shipyards during World War II. The old-fashioned unusual flowers of orange-gold suffused with pink are surely reminiscent of that era. **Grows to the height of 3-4' tall with a 3' spread.** The moderate fruity & spice fragrance is the perfect complement to these cultural icons. Full sun Zone 6



RUBY RUBY

(LATIN: ROSA WEKSACTRUMI) Proof that it's the little things that count, this striking miniature rose makes a BIG impact in the landscape. From late spring until fall's first frost, large clusters of cheery cherry-red blooms cover a compact, rounded plant that grows only 18" high. Colour holds fast until the very end, and deep green, glossy foliage and excellent disease resistance add to its immense appeal. Full sun to part shade Zone 4



SEXY REXY

(LATIN: ROSA FLORIBUNDA) Just about the most profuse blooming rose. Clusters and sprays jam-packed with perfect, pink 3 1/2" blooms. This is a fabulous continual blooming floribunda, but not perfect as it lacks fragrance. Beautiful none the less. Very vigorous. Grows to be 3' tall with a 2-3' spread. Full sun Zone 6



SWEET MADEMOISELLE

(LATIN: ROSA) An award-winning rose with intense fragrance! This tea rose features tight, high-centered blooms, with a bounty of petals which range from peach to deep apricot depending on the temperature. Its boundless beauty is matched only by its intense fragrance which is powerful enough to perfume the entire garden by itself. Grows 5' tall with a 3-4' spread. Disease resistant. Full sun Zone 5



TOP GUN

(LATIN: ROSA WEKmoridahor) Long-lasting, dark red flowers are 2.5 to 3 inches in diameter and bloom in clusters all summer. Flowers have a moderate fruity fragrance. **Matures at 3 to 4 feet tall and wide**. Excellent disease resistant Rose. Beautiful in mass plantings. Full sun Zone 4



WHITEOUT

(LATIN: ROSA WHITEOUT) Pure white blooms that pop against dark foliage. This compact landscape shrub produces 3-3½" flowers with yellow centers and a lovely citrus fragrance. Dark green and burgundy foliage. Drought-tolerant. **Reaches 3-4' tall and wide**. Full sun Zone 5-9
